The 18th annual sale proceeds through Saturday. More than 3,000 consignors, buyers and breeders and their wives have already filled all readily available motels and hotels in the city.

Judging and grading of 311 "Red Bluff Type" Hereford-pooled and horned-begins tomorrow at 8 a.m. on the Tehama County Fairgrounds and site for the nationally-known event.

The bulls will be inspected, prodded and examined by a committee of four well-known, sharp-eyed judges. Any defects in legs, feet, general soundness or condition will keep the bull from selling.
