### Nikita Emerges As Top Dog Western Observers Report

MOSCOW (UPI)—Western observers said today that Premier Nikita S. Khrushchev emerged from the 21st Communist Party congress as Russia's undisputed leader with complete approval for his policy of economic challenge to the West.

The congress fully endorsed his seven-year-plan for economic development of the Soviet Union. Every one of the speeches at the nine-day meeting gave him almost unanimous approval, praising his wisdom, initiative and boldness.

### Death Claims Comedy Star

MEADVILLE, Pa. (AP)—Death has claimed a second former member of the "Our Gang" movie comedy cast within the past three weeks.

Don Law, 38, who played "Fats" in some 20 of the old-time child comedy films, died here Thursday after a brief illness.

Carl (Alfalfa) Switzer, 32, was shot to death Jan. 21 in Van Nuys, Calif., in a fight over \$50.

There was not a hint of criticism in any of the speeches of his foreign and domestic policies. All indications were the Communist Party Central Committee now would meet to place its stamp of approval on the Khrushchev program, and draw decrees to carry out resolutions passed by the congress.

Western observers here predicted the Central Committee also would show its confidence in Khrushchev by expelling the three members of the anti-party group still in its ranks — former Premier Nikolai Bulganin, Mikhail Pervukhin and Maxim Saburov—and elect new members.

### Ike Planning More Hunting

THOMASVILLE, Ga. (AP) — President Eisenhower plans more quail hunting today after dividing a 20-bird bag his first time out this vacation.

The President and his host, former Secretary of the Treasury George M. Humphrey, got a promise of continuing good weather.

They spent seven hours in the fields of Humphrey's big plantation estate Thursday. And at day's end White House press secretary James C. Hagerly reported they brought down 20 quail between them.

Hagerly said he had no information on how many birds each man got. Newsmen are not permitted on the plantation. The daily legal limit is a dozen quail a hunter. At night Eisenhower and Humphrey played bridge again with

### Jury Excused In Beck Trial

TACOMA, Wash. (AP) — The jury in the Dave Beck tax trial was excused Thursday until Tuesday but attorneys for both sides were ordered to report in federal court Monday.

Judge George H. Boldt asked the attorneys to appear in order to determine whether certain witnesses should be required to testify for the defense.

A witness Thursday, Paul Garrett, Internal Revenue Service agent, continued to summarize Beck's financial affairs during the years 1950-53, the period in which the former Teamsters' Union president is accused of evading \$240,000 in income taxes.

Garrett said \$227,000 of union funds was paid to persons who in turn paid bills for Beck or used the money to increase the union leader's assets.

Beck's attorney, Charles Burdell, protested admission of Garrett's testimony as evidence but was overruled by Judge Boldt.

"The basic data itself is the evidence," the judge told the jury. "The summaries themselves add nothing to the weight of the evidence."

Garrett is the next to last prosecution witness to testify before the government rests its case.

a "thaw." But not once did he suggest a change in the Soviet position on Berlin, Germany, and the Far and Middle East.

and Communist Party secretary was accompanied by mass acceptance of his thesis that to accomplish all its goals Russia must be friendly and flexible on the outside and tough and consistent on the inside.

Nowhere was this more evident than in Khrushchev's closing speech, in which he invited President Eisenhower to come to Russia while at the same time condemning Vice President Richard M. Nixon and Secretary of State John Foster Dulles for "bellicose phraseology" to prevent an end to the cold war.

Khrushchev took special pains to tell the world that Russia was tired of the cold war and wanted
