LDS Members Will Listen To Salt Lake City Elders

Members of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints (Mormon) in this area will hear two high-ranking officials from Salt Lake City during a two-day conference of the Klamath Stake scheduled for Saturday and Sunday, February 14 and 15, in Medford.

The visitors are Elder Henry D. Taylor, an assistant to the Council of the Twelve Apostles and Elder Mark B. Garfield, a member of the Church Welfare Committee.

The public is invited to general sessions Sunday at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. It is announced by Stake President Carroll W. Smith, 806 Clay Street, Ashland.

Elder Taylor held several other positions before becoming an as-

stant to the Council of Twelve, including bishop, stake president, mission president and chairman of regions of the Church Welfare Plan. He is also active in civic and community affairs.

Elder Garfield is a director of the Klamath Church Welfare Plan. Other conference speakers will include local priesthood members, who conduct all religious and recreational programs of the church without pay.

Each local congregation conducts weekly programs including Sunday Schools, Sacramental Services, Primary Association, Young Men's and Young Women's Mutual Improvement Associations, Relief Society, and Priesthood Quorums.

The Mormon maxim, "The Glory of God is Intelligence," leads to scriptural study from the Holy Bible and the Book of Mormon, plus instruction in such fields as homecraft, literature, the arts, genealogy, and character improvement.

Most congregations support local members as full-time missionaries for two to three year periods in all parts of the world. They also operate welfare projects, designed to provide commodities for balanced living and in the event of disaster.

The church also has an extensive formal educational system, including seminaries, institutes, junior colleges and Brigham Young University at Provo, Utah.

6 To Attend Music Meet

Six music students from Klamath Union High School have been chosen to take part in the All-Northwest Band, Chorus and Orchestra meeting to be held in Seattle March 1. Chosen on the recommendation of their directors and principal, Charles Carlson are Carolyn Bullard, orchestra; Peggy Seideman, Judy McFarlan, Bob Harris and Bill Haman, chorus; Gary Breneman, band.

Those students honored with invitations will assemble in Seattle, March 3 to begin intensive training under nationally known conductors. Don Craig former conductor of the Fred Waring Chorus, will conduct the chorus. Craig has recently expanded the field of music composition and has been conducting large festival groups throughout the United States.

Dr. Stanley Chappel, head of the music department of the University of Washington, former conductor of the BBC Symphony in England and assistant conductor of the St. Louis Symphony, will handle the baton for the orchestra, and the band will appear under the direction of Erik Leidzen, internationally famous composer and arranger.

Their training will be climaxed by a concert in the Civic Auditorium in Seattle for the final meeting of the Biannual Convention of Northwest Music Educators Association.

Selected music students from Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Montana, Wyoming and Alaska will be included in the group. There will be 200 students in the band, 200 in the orchestra and 500 in the chorus.
