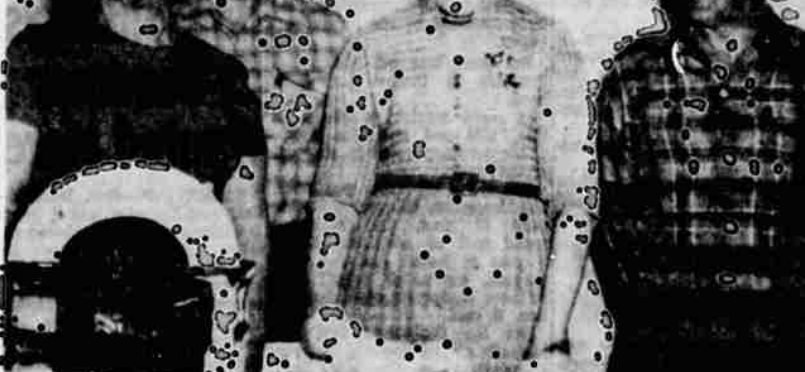
OTTAWA (AP)—A meeting in New York Tuesday has been scheduled by the American and Canadian sections of the International Commission on the St. Lawrence River.
