SAVORY CRUMB TOPPED FISH

1 cup ripe olives
4 fillets of sole
1 teaspoon salt
Pepper
2 cups flax seed bread crumbs
1/2 cup chili sauce
2 tablespoons pickle relish
2 tablespoons chopped parsley
1 1/2 teaspoons instant minced onion or 2 tablespoons finely chopped green onion
2 tablespoons melted butter or margarine

Cut olives into medium-sized pieces. Place fish in greased shallow baking dish and sprinkle with salt and pepper. Blend together bread crumbs, chili sauce, pickle relish, parsley, onion, butter and

WESTERN SUPPER SANDWICH

4 slices bread
1 medium-sized avocado
4 slices processed American cheese
1 medium-sized tomato
4 slices bacon

Toast bread on one side under broiler. Cut avocado into halves and remove seed and skin. Cut fruit into thin slices and arrange over untoasted side of bread. Cover with a cheese slice. Top with thin slices tomato. Cut bacon strips into halves and place two half-strips on top of each sandwich. Return to broiler with sandwiches about five inches from heat, and cook until bacon is browned and crisp. Serve at once. Serves four.
