BAB-O PADS

Scouring pads are a must in most households. Made of metal-wool, they are remarkably resistant to rust and crumbling.

To use, moisten the pad, squeeze it until it is sudsy, rub surface to be cleaned with a circular motion and leave pad sudsy to dry until the next use. Rinse well the surface cleaned.

The pads are woven to make them firmer, more compact and longer-lasting.

GELATIN SALAD

A refreshing gelatin salad is always popular. "Emerald Salad Mold" is a handsome creation of raisins, carrot and green chili in a lime-flavored gelatin. It can be chilled in a large fancy mold, individual molds or in a square or round cake pan. Serve on crisp watercress or other salad greens with mayonnaise. You'll like the tangy-sweetness of the raisins in this delicious spring salad.

EMERALD SALAD MOLD

- 1/2 cup light or dark raisins
- 1 package lime-flavored gelatin
- 1 cup hot water
- 1 cup cold water
- 1/2 cup grated carrot
- 1/4 cup finely cut canned green chili pepper
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce
- Shredded lettuce
- Mayonnaise

Cover raisins with water and boil three or four minutes. Drain and cool. Dissolve gelatin in hot water. Stir in cold water and chili until slightly thickened. Fold in raisins, carrot, chili pepper, salt and Worcestershire sauce. Turn into mold and chill until firm. Unmold on lettuce-garnished plate. Top each serving with mayonnaise.

Makes six servings.

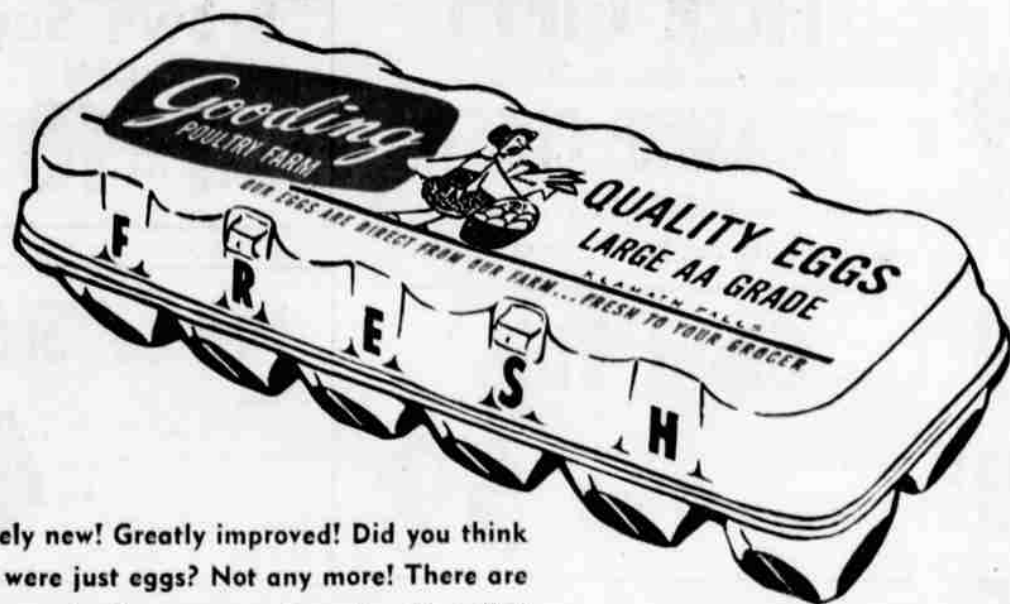
