Ike Places Dulles Atop Roster Of Secretaries

WASHINGTON (UPI) — From Thomas Jefferson through John Foster Dulles, 51 men have served as U. S. Secretary of State.

Some of them, like Jefferson, have found little to do in the job. Others, like Dulles, have carried enormous responsibilities and have made indelible personal marks on the pages of history.

President Eisenhower regards Dulles as the greatest secretary of state the nation has ever had, and has delegated him to a massive role in determining the U. S. course in world affairs.

Former President Harry S. Truman also thought highly of his secretary of state, Dean Acheson, and gave him a relatively free hand in the detailed execution of U. S. foreign policy. But Acheson's authority was never as great as Dulles' has been. When basic decisions had to be made—such as the decision to intervene in the Korean War—Truman made them.

Many dynamic presidents, like Woodrow Wilson and Franklin D. Roosevelt, have insisted on carrying out in person their constitutional responsibility for U. S. Foreign relations.

The roster of secretaries of state includes some of the most famous names in U. S. history. But many of them achieved renown before or after, rather than during, their tenure in the number one cabinet post. That was true, for example, of Jefferson. It was also true of the five other secretaries who later became presidents — James Madison, James Monroe, John Quincy Adams, Martin Van Buren and James Buchanan.

John Marshall is remembered as the first U. S. Chief Justice, rather than the second secretary of state, Henry Clay. Daniel Webster and John C. Calhoun also served as secretaries of state, but their place in history stems from their service in the Senate rather than in the cabinet.

The late Cordell Hull, FDR's secretary of state for 12 years, recorded in his memoirs the observation that "no secretary of state who has sought to play a positive role in foreign affairs has emerged unscathed by battles."

Dulles and Acheson, both targets of violent criticism, can at least to this statement. So, if he were alive, could William H. Seward, secretary of state under Lincoln and Johnson, who reaped a whirlwind of public and Congressional abuse for his "folly" in filling that vacant post with a fast acting classified ad Dial TU 4-8111 today to start yours.
