SWEETBREADS

PINEAPPLE-BETTY

Once in a blue moon, a magic recipe with a surprise ending comes along. No one would guess that this spicy-crunchy, yet cobler-like dessert, came from such a quick and easy recipe. The ingredients are the kind one usually has on hand, so in addition to being a family favorite, Surprise Pineapple-Betty is the ideal emergency dessert. You'll have fun with your secret surprise, so don't tell how little it cost in time and money.

SURPRISE PINEAPPLE-BETTY
8 slices stale bread
1 can (1 lb., 4 1/2-oz.) Dole Crushed Pineapple
1/2 cup sugar
1/2 stick butter, chilled
cinnamon and nutmeg
Remove crusts and toast bread very lightly on both sides in oven broiler; watch closely. Reset oven to 350 degrees, then cut toast into cubes and spread half over the bottom of shallow 8-inch square, or comparable, pan. Cover with half of pineapple and scatter half over all. Repeat whole procedure, using rest of ingredients, and sprinkle top with a little cinnamon and nutmeg, then bake, uncovered, for 30 minutes. Good hot or cold, but especially good

St. Patrick Salad

Party-pretty salads are often in demand — especially good make-ahead gelatin ones. "Mist Green Souffle Salads" is such a salad — one you might keep in mind for St. Patrick's Day. Pale green Calavo avocado, lime-flavored gelatin and cream cheese give it a misty green color. This rich, delicious, creamy combination, with tangy orange sections added for extra goodness, will appeal to all tastes. It will be a salad you'll serve often.

MIST GREEN SOUFFLE SALAD

1 package lime-flavored gelatin
1 cup hot water
1/2 cup cold water
1/2 cup spoon fresh lime or lemon juice
1/2 cup mayonnaise

1 avocado
1 large orange
2 (3-ounce) packages cream cheese
Salad greens
Dissolve gelatin in hot water. Stir in cold water and lime juice. Add mayonnaise and beat until smooth with rotary beater. Turn into refrigerator tray and place in freezing compartment 15 to 20 minutes, until mixture is set about one inch in from edges but soft in center. Meanwhile cut avocado into halves, remove seed and skin and dice fruit. Pare, quarter and slice orange. Turn gelatin mixture into bowl and beat with rotary beater until light and fluffy. Add softened cheese and beat again. Fold in avocado cubes and orange. Spoon into individual molds, and chill until firm. Unmold on salad greens.
Makes 6 (6-ounce) molds.
