Alaska-Bound Pioneers Slowed By Severe Storm

ANGOLA, Ind. (AP) — The Alaska-bound pioneers from Detroit had it rough Thursday—the first day of their 4,300-mile journey—by a severe Midwestern snowstorm could slow them down even more today.

Winds up to 30 miles per hour piled up heavy snow from Oklahoma to Michigan, and across the path of the modern day wagon train.

The pioneers, who left Detroit Thursday morning and made a mere 130 miles to a state park here because of bad breaks, are scheduled to reach Wisconsin by nightfall. Parts of Wisconsin and Illinois are blanketed by more than eight inches of snow.

In spite of obstacles, the Michigan-bound pioneers are not discouraged in their hopes of reaching the virgin Keweenaw Peninsula—where they plan to homestead 160 acres apiece—in about three weeks.

The group includes 13 men, 10 women and 14 children. There are 10 married couples and three single men, Yvonne Stevens, 22, quit her job as a business machine operator to join the caravan, but got stranded in Detroit by trailer hitch trouble. She hopes to catch up today.

The last vehicle of the motorcade had hardly left the Motor City when the lead car pulled off for gasoline near Monroe, Mich. The others trailed around a corner

after their leader, but kept going for two miles—on the wrong road.

Another delay came near the Ohio-Indiana border when one of the 12 vehicles blew a tire during a snowstorm. True to pioneer tradition, the whole caravan pulled over to help.

Turnpike guards opened a special gate to speed the 30ers on their way. A highway patrol car stayed within hailing distance.

The modern-day pioneers pulled their vehicles into a tight circle on the service drive of a turnpike rest stop as they halted for lunch. Most of them ate in their cars to stretch funds.

They had hoped to make their first overnight stop near Chicago. The delays, however, caused them to spend the night at Pokagon State Park near here.

SHANNON, Ireland (AP) — A four-engine Super Constellation cargo plane named Super Connie landed safely here Thursday night after trouble with two engines over the Atlantic.
