Russell Pengelly, Fremont instructor and science coordinator for the program, indicated that the elementary schools and KUHS will take part in the Science Fair Exposition. Winners in various categories will be sent to the Seventh Annual Northwest Science Exposition which will be held in Portland April 19 through April 26.

The Science Fair will be divided into school competition and graduate into regional competition between schools.

Ex-GOP Leader Gets Probation

PORTLAND (AP)—Charles P. Ohling, once active in many Republican Party campaigns in Oregon, Tuesday was placed on probation for two years on an income tax charge.

Ohling, 67, a public relations man here, was charged with failing to file federal tax returns for 1954 and 1955.

As he pronounced sentence, U.S. District Judge William East said: "It is hard to believe that a man of affairs engaged in political campaigns can be unaware of the need to file income tax returns."

Masons Schedule Fete For Tutors

MALIN — Former teachers who have served in schools of Malin, Merrill and Bonanza, communities within the district of the Malin Masonic Lodge are to be honored at a reception by the lodge on Tuesday, April 7, in the Malin Masonic Hall. The meeting will convene at 7:30 p.m. and is open to the public.

Each school will furnish part of the entertainment and each teacher is to be presented with a certificate of appreciation for their years of service, signed by the grand masonic master of Oregon and John Freitag, master of the Malin lodge.

Students may enter an exhibit in either physical science or biological science and the categories are divided into four brackets. The physical science section is divided into senior individual for grades 10, 11 and 12; junior individual for grades 7, 8, and 9; intermediate individual for grades 4, 5, and 6, and primary individual for the first three grades.

The biological science section is divided into senior dual for grades 10, 11 and 12; junior dual, grades 7, 8 and 9; intermediate dual, grades 4, 5 and 6, and primary group for first three grades.

Pengelly indicated that more than 200 entries were expected in the fair.

Some of the elementary schools have either had their fairs or are planning them. They must be completed prior to the regional fair which will include all schools and will be held at KUHS on April 10 and 11.

Objective of the Science Fair is to give students an opportunity to do science work outside regular classroom work, and to give those interested in science an opportunity for recognition.

The judging will be on the basis of 10 per cent of the entries giving first place, 20 per cent second, 20 per cent third and 20 per cent
