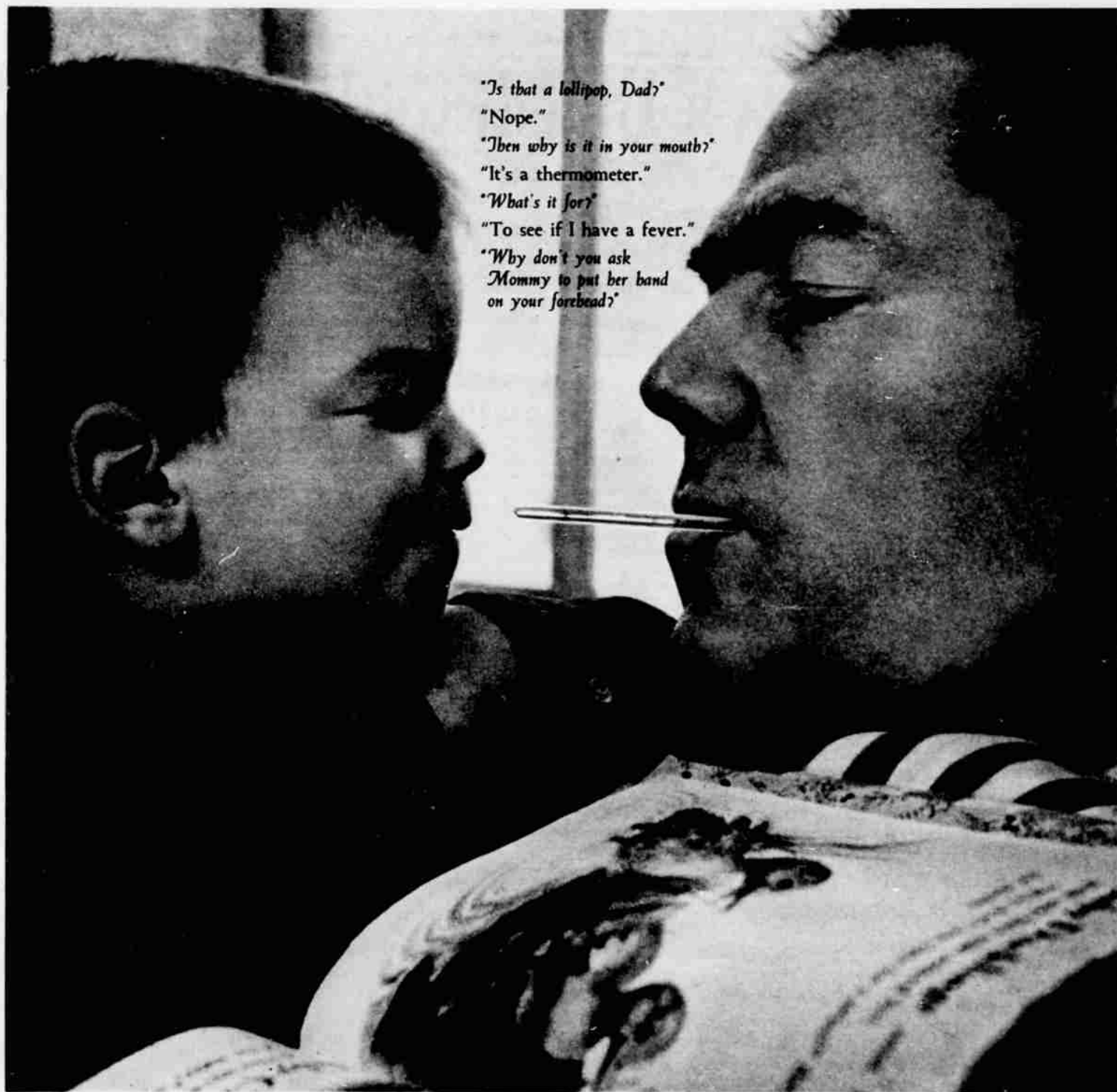




"Is that a lollipop, Dad?"
