

New Crooner Due In Fall

ISHPEMING, Mich. (AP) — Bing Crosby's wife has confirmed she is an expectant mother again.

The crooner's wife — Kathy Grant — made the announcement Sunday after she arrived to begin work on a picture, "The Anatomy of a Murder." She said the baby is expected in September or October.

Crosby's marriage to the pretty brown-eyed actress Oct. 24, 1957, surprised friends and relatives although they had been dating four years. He was 53 and she was 23.

The singer's first wife, Dixie Lee, died in 1952 after a long illness.

Kathy gave birth to a son last August. He was named Harry Lillis Crosby III, but Bing nicknamed him "Tex" in honor of Kathy's home state.

Crosby has four other sons by his first wife. They are Gary, 26; twins Dennis and Phillip, 24; and Lindsay, 23.

Band Plays For Old Vet

HOUSTON, Tex. (AP) — A 65-piece American Legion band serenaded the Civil War's only surviving soldier Sunday.

And Walter Williams, 116, beat time on his bed with his left hand, clutching a cigar in his right, and said: "I wish I had some popcorn."

Ira Cox, business manager of the band, gave Williams a Confederate flag and said, "We'll come out and serenade him whenever he asks." The band played "Camp-town Races," "The Vanished Army," and "Down South."

Williams repeated the words to some of the songs. And a television entertainer sang the final song just before Williams dropped off into his afternoon nap.

SAN ANTONIO, Tex. (AP) — More attention to the party platform and more counsel with fellow Democrats was demanded of Majority Leader Lyndon B. Johnson (D-Tex.) by Texas Young Democrats Sunday.

At the closing session of their state convention, the Young Democrats adopted a resolution to that effect drafted by Jack Matthews of Houston. The vote was 209-73.

Tokyo Miners End Strike

TOKYO (AP) — A two-week strike by 185,000 coal miners ended Monday.

The miners demanded a monthly raise of \$5.55 but settled for \$1.67. Wages before the strike averaged \$6.66 a month.

The strike cut production 70 per cent, or 1,610,000 tons during the two-week period.

CAUSE TRAFFIC JAM COLLINSVILLE, Calif. (UPI) — Thousands of San Francisco Bay area residents caused a traffic jam here Sunday while visiting California's newest tourist attraction—this town, which floods each time the Sacramento River has high tide.

Billy Opens NZ Crusade

WELLINGTON, New Zealand. (AP) — Prime Minister Walter Nash and 40,000 other New Zealanders braved a biting autumn wind Sunday to hear Billy Graham.

The American evangelist opened a Wellington crusade after drawing record crowds in Auckland.

The evangelist told his audience the SEATO conference being held in Wellington is a symptom of the sickness of the world. He said efforts for a cure are in vain unless mankind returns to Christ.

More than 2,000 persons came forward to make "decisions for Christ," bringing the total so far in the New Zealand campaign to nearly 10,000. Among the group Sunday were 13 of 120 prisoners in a Christchurch jail who heard Graham by a telephone hookup.

APPLE POLISHER MONTGOMERY, Ala. (UPI) — School Superintendent Frank Stewart arrived at a legislative finance committee hearing Friday with a polished red apple. Then he asked for a 40 million dollar increase in his budget.

This corresponded to the Redwood Valley in Mendocino County from where most calls came from residents. Police at Ukiah, county seat, got most of the calls. It was felt slightly in Ukiah.

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Reds Jeopardize Talks With New Propaganda

WASHINGTON (UPI) — American officials said today the Russians themselves were jeopardizing the forthcoming East-West talks with a new series of propaganda statements on the Berlin situation.

They said the statements, issued even before the foreign ministers could get set for their Geneva meeting, could hardly be viewed as examples of the "sincere desire to negotiate" that President Eisenhower has said the Soviets must show to justify a summer summit meeting.

The latest Soviet charge said a high altitude American transport flight to West Berlin was an attempt to wreck agreement on the East-West talks.

Mart Receipts Found In Bag

ALLEN PARK, Mich. (AP) — Mrs. Irene Manke, an Allen Park housewife, struck it rich at the supermarket Sunday.

When she got home and began putting her groceries away she found a paper bag containing hundreds of dollars in cash, plus a lot of checks. She said she didn't count it but called the store manager, who rushed over to retrieve the day's receipts.

"He didn't even thank me," she said.

Three Soviet fighter planes buzzed an Air Force transport on Good Friday as it flew to and from Berlin. In a note Sunday, Russia said the American plane committed a "gross violation" of Berlin corridor flight regulations by flying at 25,000 feet.

State Department officials pointed out there never had been any agreement to limit the altitude at which Allied planes could fly in the air corridors to Berlin.

The Soviet note said, "the deliberate violations... can hardly be regarded otherwise than as an attempt of the United States to worsen conditions for a foreign ministers meeting, if not to frustrate completely the agreement on East-West talks."

American officials said it was the Russians themselves who jeopardized East-West conferences by buzzing the American transport and by putting restrictions last week on travel of foreign diplomats in Russia.
