Negro's Play Wins Award

NEW YORK (UPI)—"A Raisin in the Sun" by Lorraine Hansberry was voted the best American play of the 1958-59 theatrical season Tuesday by the New York Drama Critics' Circle.

Circle citations in the secondary categories of best foreign play and best musical went, respectively, to Friedrich Dürrenmatt's "The Visit" and a French revue, "La Plume de Ma Tante." Miss Hansberry's drama of Negro life in a Chicago tenement, which opened here March 11, was her first produced work, and she is the first Negro woman to have a play presented on Broadway.

Her play received six votes. Tied for second, with five votes each, were "Sweet Bird of Youth" by Tennessee Williams and "J.B." by Archibald MacLeish. Eugene O'Neill's "A Touch of the Poet" received three votes.

Election Victor Finds Difference

OKLAHOMA CITY, Okla. (AP)—James H. Norick knows what a difference three weeks makes. He has been chosen mayor by 23,000 votes over insurance man Charles Burba.

Three weeks ago Norick, a printing firm executive, ran third in the primary election, 62 votes out of the second place runoff berth. He asked a recount and won by one vote over attorney Merton Bulla.
