

Mrs. Nicholas Tells Jury Of Shooting

INDIANAPOLIS (AP)—Minnie B. (Connie) Nicholas told her murder trial jury today she had left her fickle lover's parked car without knowing he had been shot while they struggled.

The 44-year-old double divorcee said in her long-delayed testimony about the shooting last July 31 that her little pearl-handled revolver had gone off while her ex-lover, Forrest Teel, twisted her arm.

"I didn't know Mr. Teel had been hit—I would not have left him," she said.

She broke down in sobs and had to be helped from the witness stand when the court recessed just after she had told the details of the shooting and her subsequent suicide attempt, in despair over Teel's new romance.

"He hit me, and I remember taking the gun from my purse," she told the jury of 12 married men. "Simultaneously, he struck me and threw me back across the seat."

"He grabbed my arm, and the gun went off."

"He continued holding my arm and twisting it. I felt a crack in my upper arm, and I tried to get loose. Finally he let go of my arm, and I got out of the car."

"I looked back, and he was sitting up. The car was in motion."

"Connie, do you know how many shots were fired?" asked Charles W. Symmes, one of her lawyers.

"I know there was one shot. I was told later there were three additional shots."

"During the time of the shooting, did Mr. Teel say anything?"

"We were struggling over the gun."

"Did you know Mr. Teel had been shot?"

"I didn't know Mr. Teel had been hit. I would not have left him. I could see his car was in motion, and I thought I was being followed by him."

Mrs. Nicholas said she still thought Teel was following her when she drove to a secluded riverbank, to take the 75 sleeping pills she had mixed in pineapple juice.

"Another car came over the embankment and turned off its lights," she said.

She said she had locked herself into her car and swallowed some of the drug mixture, vomited it, then taken more.

Kin Reunited After Years

HOUSTON, Tex. (AP)—Two sisters, each thinking the other dead for 44 years, found both were wrong.

Ida O'Daniel of Corning, Ark., believed her sister, Martha Liles, was killed in a 1915 tornado. Letters written to Mrs. Liles at Honey Island were returned after the tornado.

Mrs. Liles thought her sister was dead because her letters were returned after a flood at Corning the same year.

C. A. O'Daniel, son of Mrs. O'Daniel, located his aunt by Kountze, near Honey Island, on a hunch.

The sisters were reunited this week at the home of Mrs. Liles' daughter, Mrs. J. L. Johnson.

GOP Gathers For Choosing Of Meet Site

WASHINGTON (AP)—The Republican National Committee gathered today for a two-day meeting to further its party rebuilding plan, choose a new chairman and pick a convention site.

The important decisions will come Saturday when a new chairman is elected to succeed the retiring Meade Alcorn and the party settles on a place and date for the 1960 nominating convention.

Unless there's a last minute hitch, Sen. Thurston B. Morton of Kentucky, middle-of-the-road supporter of President Eisenhower, will be elected chairman. Alcorn is returning to his law practice in Hartford, Conn.

Morton would hold the party post without giving up his Senate seat, but would serve only through the 1960 convention. The presidential nominee chosen then would determine whether the chairmanship should change hands.

The matter of a convention city was still up in the air today, but a site committee will come up with a recommendation Saturday for action by the full committee.

Principal stumbling block was a difference of opinion over whether the convention should be held in late July or early August. Party officials said a Chicago convention starting July 25 is still the best bet, although that city could be eliminated if an August date were chosen. Chicago's bid was restricted to a July 25 date.

Five other cities — Philadelphia, New York, San Francisco, Miami Beach and Los Angeles — offered to take the convention anytime between July 15 and August 15.

Lad's Neck Wear Said Real Sporty

TUCSON, Ariz. (AP)—John Boykin's neck wear attracted some attention in a department store Thursday.

Boykin, of Tucson, strolled into the store wearing a bright checked shirt with a four-foot bull snake wrapped around his neck.

Boykin said he caught the snake on a picnic and thought it looked "real sporty" with his shirt.

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Rubber Firm Closed Down By Strike

NEW YORK (AP)—About 26,000 production workers of the U.S. Rubber Co. struck after midnight Thursday at the company's 18 plants across the nation.

A company spokesman said the workers walked out after negotiations here failed to reach agreement on union demands for improvements in fringe benefits. The proposals include pensions, insurance, severance pay and a supplemental unemployment benefit plan.

A spokesman for the union, the United Rubber Workers, told NBC News the union seeks to bring its fringe benefits up to those enjoyed by the United Auto Workers. He did not elaborate.

Wages are not an issue. Wages normally are negotiated during the summer with U.S. Rubber as well as with other major producers in the rubber industry. The industry employs nearly a quarter of a million workers.

The strike followed the mid-night expiration of the union's contract with U.S. Rubber. Contracts of other members of rubber's big four—Goodyear, Goodyear and Firestone—expire April 15.

Both U.S. Rubber and union spokesmen followed past policy of not discussing proposed contract provisions in detail during negotiations.

The struck plants are in Los Angeles and Santa Ana, Calif.; Chicago; Mishawaka, Indianapolis and Washington, Ind.; Eau Claire, Wis.; Philadelphia, Pa.; Painesville, Ohio; Detroit; Passaic and North Bergen, N.J.; Woonsocket and Providence, R.I.; Chicopee Falls, Mass. and three plants in Naugatuck, Conn.

U.S. Preps For Castro

WASHINGTON (AP)—The State Department is quietly mobilizing a big section of its security force to guard Cuban Prime Minister Fidel Castro during an unofficial 11-day visit starting Wednesday.

Anti-Castro demonstrations are expected to boil up in the path of his good will tour of Washington, New York, Princeton, N.J., and Cambridge, Mass. Some telephone threats and warnings already have been received by the department and the Cuban Embassy.

The elaborate step-by-step security guard will be fully as intensive as that given Soviet Dep. Premier Anastas Mikoyan during his stormy coast to coast travels last January.

Some of Castro's bearded personal bodyguards will accompany him. But the State Department has the main responsibility for shielding him from demonstrators, crackpots, potential assassins, as well as enthusiastic well wishers.

In advance of Castro's arrival, an outfit calling itself the "Anti-Communist Movement of the Americas" set up shop in a downtown hotel. A Cuban, Rafael del Pino, who identifies himself as a former associate of Castro, began turning out publicity releases as local representative. These have called Castro "Traitor of the Americas," "bully," and "assassin," and claimed he was following a pro-Soviet policy.

Pelicans Tonight

SAN CARLOS (UPI)—William Dobert, 66, suffered a heart attack Thursday and died — while his wife pleaded for 17 minutes for someone to get off their party line.

Mrs. Elma Dobert told police her husband suffered the attack about 11 a.m. She tried to telephone his doctor but the party line caller refused to relinquish the line.

Finally the line was cleared, and Mrs. Dobert called the fire department. The firemen arrived in four minutes, but it was too late.

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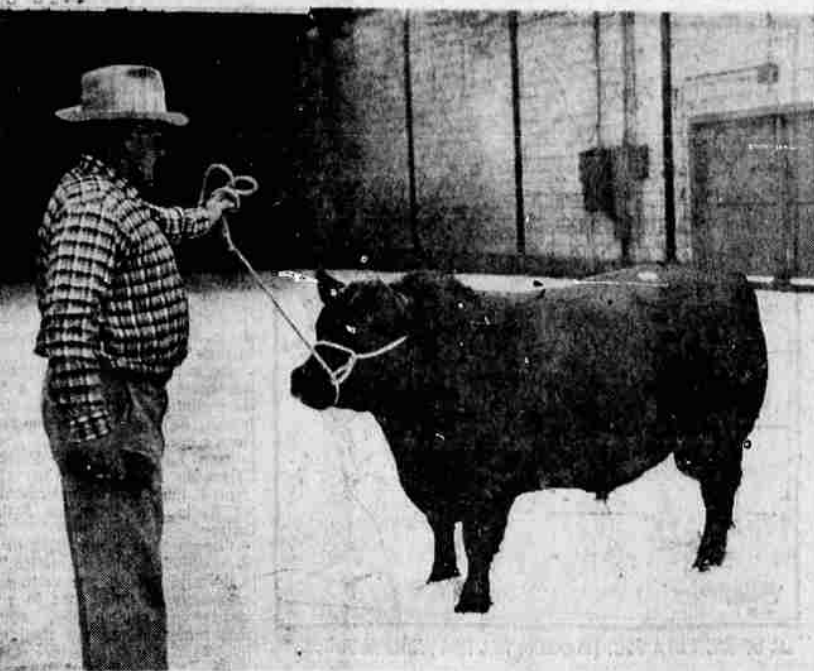

Sportsarama Set Saturday

The fifth annual 20-30 Club Sportsarama is just about ready to open up at the fairgrounds tomorrow.

The sporting goods show, offering 11 booths full of latest boats, motors, fishing equipment and so forth, will run tomorrow and Sunday from 11 a.m. until 9 p.m.

The show is expected to draw more than 5,000 visitors. Admission is free. Proceeds from entry fees posted by the six local merchants who will display goods will enrich the 20-30 fund for children.

A valuable door prize will be awarded to a visitor each day of the show.

Featured will be several cabin cruisers—one or two so big they'll be displayed outside the exhibition building in which the Sportsarama will be held.

Last year's show was held at the New Klamath Falls armory. Space was restricted, and people didn't know where it was, Ted Houser, Sportsarama co-chairman said.

But 2,500 people came. Display and parking room at the fairgrounds is more than ample, and 20-30 members expect a record crowd.

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
