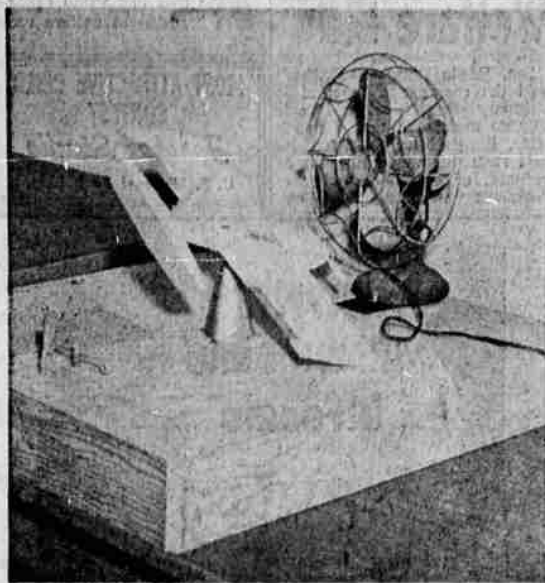

Choral Group To Sing Here

The Choralaires Choir of Bible Standard College is making its annual spring tour and will bring a special service of sacred music to Klamath Temple at 1007 Pine Street at 7:30 p.m. Sunday, April 12.

The Choralaires have traveled on the coast by special bus extensively during the past school year. It is under the direction of Bernice Kovacs, a graduate of the Wisconsin Conservatory of Music. A varied program of classic and hymn arrangements will be presented. Trios, quartets, and other arrangements will also be featured.

Also, accompanying the choir, will be the Rev. Harvey C. Klapstein, president of the school, who will speak briefly at the service.

This choir of 32 voices is considered one of the outstanding choirs of the Northwest. The speaker, the Rev. Klapstein, has a varied ministry, and has spent much time in Jamaica, B.W.I., opening a Bible school there, as well as developing choirs for the natives. He was one of the first Americans to see the great possibilities in Jamaica.

The Rev. Harry M. Strachan, pastor of Klamath Temple, will bring the morning sermon at 11

a.m. His topic will be "The Certainties of Pentecost." The message of the early church will be repeated again. Sunday school convenes at 9:45 a.m.

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Ager Blasts Davis Bill

TULELAKE—Earl Ager, Siskiyou County supervisor, reported that a delegation from Tulelake and Butte Valley appeared before the Tuesday meeting of the Board of Supervisors in Yreka to protest Water Bill No. 1892, proposed by Assemblywoman Pauline Davis.

The bill would set up a county water agency, authorized to handle any aspect of the water situation, countywide or area-wide. The agency could build dams and have control over the handling of all water usage.

Maurice Strantz, manager of the Tulelake Irrigation District, assures Tulelake farmers that such an agency would have no control or authority in the Tulelake District, however, Butte Valley farmers do not have the same protection.

A delegation will meet with the Northern California Supervisors Association at Redding, April 17.

Bus Blows Tire; Hits Two Cars

An Oregon Technical Institute bus loaded with 21 OTI students blew a front tire Thursday morning in front of Henley store on Highway 36 and veered into two cars operated by Henley High School students.

All three vehicles were damaged extensively, but no one was injured.

Oregon State Police officers who investigated the case said the bus, driven by Almon Lewis Geiss, who lives at OTI, first smashed into a car operated by John Larry Miller, 17, of Route 1, Klamath Falls.

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served, also. The program will begin at 7:30 p.m. in the auditorium of First Baptist Church.

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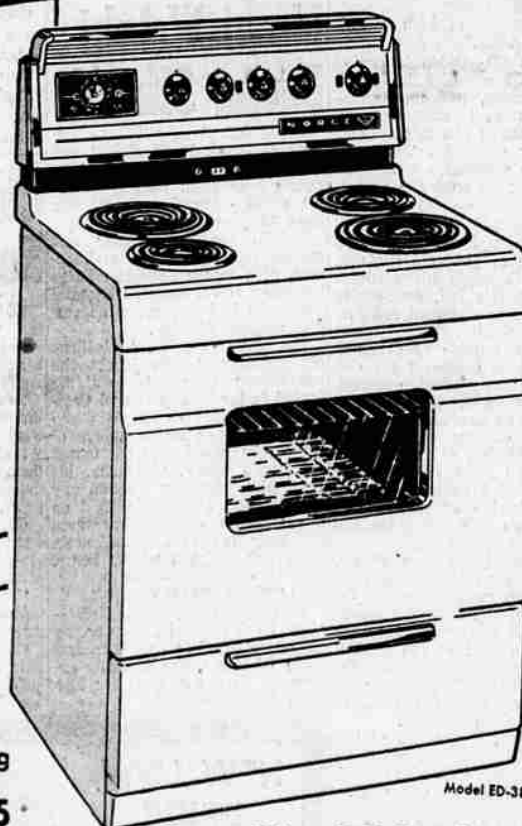
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
