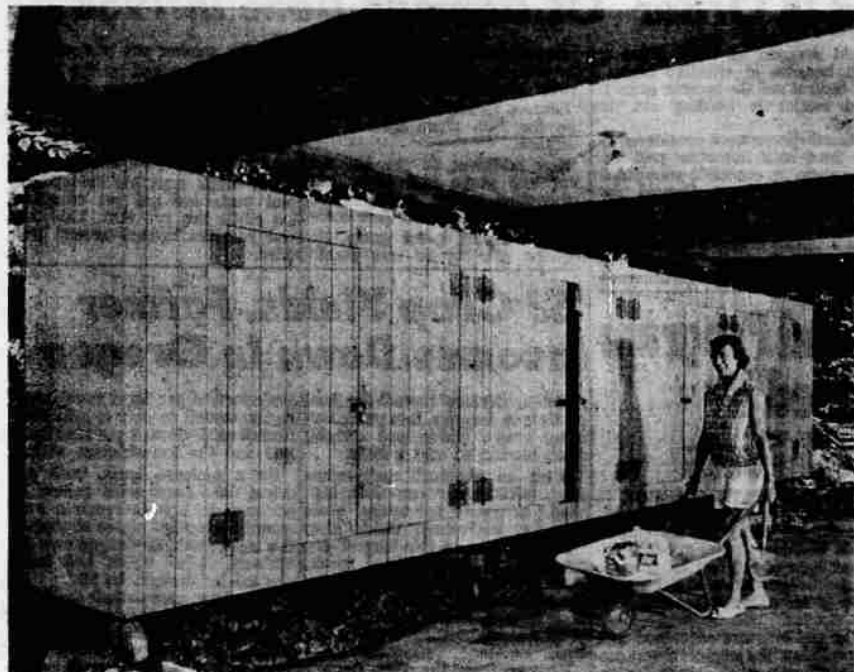

## Floating Storage Cabinet Adds To Home Utility

One of the favorite subjects of the architect's pencil is storage for the home: storage cabinets inside the house and clever storage ideas for outside.

In recent years, the carport has come in for a lot of attention as a possible storage shed. In fact, in the case of the basementless home, it usually takes over the care and keeping of steamer trunks, garden supplies, and sporting equipment.

Using the carport for these items is entirely logical, for the garden is usually adjacent to the carport and a minimum of steps between it and the wheelbarrow lightens the gardener's chore considerably. And what could be more easy than loading golf clubs or fishing rods directly from a carport cupboard into the car?

Even though cupboards have been built right into the wall connecting house and carport, it's a smart idea to incorporate storage features into at least one of the outer walls. Too much storage space is an impossibility.

For the outer wall, something in the way of decorative designing is needed. One interesting plan calls for floating storage, a cabinet which is suspended between ground and roof so that it appears to be floating unsupported in space.

The design trick is to build it around the supporting posts for the roof section (usually sturdy Douglas fir 4x4 posts) in such a manner that the posts are visible two feet below the cabinet and about two feet above. This gives the illusion that the supporting posts run through the cabinet to the roof without actually having anything to do with its framework.

The design of the floating storage cabinet is unique and guaranteed to add a world of decorative interest to the carport, but care should be taken to relate it to the house design through the type of wood chosen for its exterior.

If, for instance, the house is sided in a knotty grade of western red cedar and finished in driftwood stain, the floating cabinet should match perfectly. Doors can be installed either with interior hinges for an utterly smooth appearance or with visible hinges, and locks of some kind are an absolute must.

Items from the floating cabinet will be much easier to load and unload if the cabinet is compartmentalized with separate doors for each section.

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
