Oregon Coast Water Study Unit Founded

OREGON STATE COLLEGE — On many of the detailed oceanography maps of Pacific Coast waters, Oregon's off-shore region is blank because so little research has been done on water temperature, salinity, currents and the sediments of the ocean floor.

Establishment of a new department of oceanography at Oregon State College is aimed at filling in these blanks and providing data on Oregon's 300 miles of coastal water—fourth longest coastline of any state.

The department, approved last week by the state board of higher education, will concentrate on graduate training and research. President A. L. Strand said. Dr. Wayne V. Burt, who in 1954 started the first oceanography courses at OSC and the first extensive studies of Oregon's ocean waters and inlets, will be department head.

OSC is one of 10 institutions proposed by the office of naval research to participate in a 10-year national program of research on waters surrounding the United States and the deep ocean. If the program receives final approval, OSC research will be greatly expanded.

During the past five years, Burt has received research grants totaling more than \$65,000 from the office of naval research and another research grant of \$11,000 from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service.

Research to date has concentrated on studies of the mixing and movement of fresh river and ocean salt water in Oregon estuaries from Coos Bay to the Columbia River. Findings have economic importance from the standpoint of drainage of water pollutants and survival and development of fish, oysters and clams. The state fish commission is cooperating in the studies.

Burt is also making the first periodic readings of ocean water oxygen content, temperature and salinity off the Oregon Coast in cooperation with the Coast Guard.
