Wilderness Area Pack-In Trips Planned For 1959

Want to explore the end of the rainbow? You can, this summer, if you so desire by taking one of 15 pack trips to penetrate 11 of the outstanding wilderness areas in North America. Organized and directed by The American Forestry Association, Washington, D.C., these expeditions, known as the "Trail Riders of the Wilderness," are conducted on a nonprofit basis as part of the Association's educational services. (One trip will be made by canoes.)

These trips explore a land of enchantment seldom seen by Americans. They take you into the great roadless domains still left on our continent where lofty mountain ranges, wooded valleys and rolling meadows vie with the beauty of alpine flora and sparkling lakes. To sportsmen, to botanists, to ornithologists and nature lovers, these areas spell outdoor paradise and they cannot be matched anywhere on this earth for superb, wild and unbowed wilderness.

The trips scheduled are: the High Uintas Wilderness, Ashley National Forest, Utah, July 7 to 17; Quetico-Superior Wilderness, Superior National Forest, Minnesota (canoe trip), July 14 to 23; Wind River Mountains, Bridger Wilderness, Bridger National Forest Wyoming, July 14 to 25 and August 4 to 15; Maroon Bells-Snowmass Wilderness, White River and Gunnison national forests, Colorado, July 24 to August 3 and August 4 to 14; Sawtooth Wilderness, Sawtooth and Boise national forests, Idaho, July 28 to August 7 and August 11 to 21; Anaconda-Pintlar Wilderness, Beaverhead, Bitterroot and Deerlodge national forests, Montana, August 3 to 12; Teton Wilderness, Teton National Forest and Yellowstone National Park, Wyoming, August 10 to 21; San

Juan Wilderness, San Juan National Forest, Colorado, August 11 to 21 and August 24 to September 3; Gila Wilderness, Gila National Forest, New Mexico, August 25 to September 4; Mt. Whitney-High Sierra Wilderness, Sequoia National Park and Inyo National Forest, California, August 26 to September 4; Pecos Wilderness, Santa Fe and Carson national forests, New Mexico, September 7 to 17.

The trips begin at designated assembly points near the scenes of the various rides, and parties are limited from 20 to 25 persons each.

The American Forestry Association is the oldest national conservation organization in America. Its operation of the "Trail Riders of the Wilderness" since 1933 has become a promoting factor in the national plan to greater recreational opportunities. As a group, the Trail Riders represent a means by which any man or woman, in a normal state of health and with an average amount of riding experience, may, by sharing the cost, fully enjoy true wilderness country under experienced and organized leadership. Cooperating with the American Forestry Association are the United States Forest Service and the National Park Service, the two government agencies responsible for the administration and protection of the larger remnants of the primitive. Under this leadership more than 3,400 men and women have participated in 215 separate expeditions to the major wilderness areas of 12 states. More than 20,000 miles of wilderness trail have been explored.
