

dam closed to salmon angling entire year.

Sandy River above Viking bridge closed to fishing from or having assembled fishing tackle in or on any boat or floating device.

Santiam River Middle Fork closed to all angling from Coal Creek downstream one-half mile.

Santiam River North Fork closed to all angling from the permanent hatchery racks of the Niagara downstream for a distance of 0.5 miles.

Santiam River North Fork closed to all angling from dam on the main north and south channels of Skayton Island to point 400 feet below the dam.

Santiam River North Fork Skayton power canal closed to all angling from P.P.A.L. powerhouse downstream to first bridge.

Santiam River North Fork Skayton power canal closed to all angling from spill dam downstream to north channel approximately 300 feet.

Scott Lake is closed to angling from motor driven crafts.

Tanner Creek closed to all angling from the mouth up to Highway 30 bridge from August 15 to November 30.

Timpanogot Lake (Douglas County) closed to use of motor

boats for any purpose.

Willamette River is closed to all angling from a point 200 feet above the highway at Oregon City Falls to a line below said highway described as follows: Beginning at a point 54 feet below the southwestern corner of the electric plant on Black Point; thence to the northeastern corner of Mill A; thence from the west side of the river; thence straight downstream to a point 20 feet below the grinder room arches; thence west to the bank of the river. Provided that no angling shall be done from a boat while any part of the boat is inside the closed area.

Willamette River is closed to all angling in that part known as the tailrace of the Crown-Zellerbach Pulp and Paper Company and described as follows: Beginning at a point near the mouth of said tailrace on the south bank thereof; thence extending across said tailrace following the line established by the bridge across said tailrace to the north bank thereof; thence in a westerly southerly and easterly direction around the bank of said tailrace to the place of beginning. Provided that no angling shall be done from a boat while any part of the boat is inside the closed area.

Willamette River is closed to all angling in that portion east of a line extending from the northwesterly corner of Mill A of Publishers Paper Company, straight across the tailrace to the lap pile. Provided that no angling shall be done from a boat while any part of the boat is inside the closed area.

Willamette River and tributaries above Oregon City Falls closed to chinook salmon angling from July 1 to December 31.

Willamette River Middle Fork closed to all angling from Dexter Dam to a marker approximately one-half mile below the dam.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS AND CLOSURES

Calapooya Creek is closed to all angling from a point 200 feet above the dam at the city of Seaside water works downstream to bridge crossing road leading to Nontparell.

Smith River is closed to all angling from a point 200 feet above the falls to a point 400 feet below.

Smith River is closed to angling from or having any assembled fishing tackle in or on any boat or floating device above a point 400 feet below Smith River Falls.

Steamboat Creek and tributaries are closed to all angling.

Umpqua River Reservoirs including Scump Lake, Lemolo, Fish Creek, Tikelee and Soda Springs Reservoirs, open April 25 to October 31.

Umpqua River (North Fork) closed to all angling from Winchester Dam down to old Highway 99 bridge.

Umpqua River (North Fork) is closed to all angling from or on any boat or fishing device between Winchester Dam and Soda Springs dam and on Lemolo and Tikelee Reservoirs above posted deadlines established by the Game Commission.

Umpqua River (North Fork) closed to angling from the Soda Springs dam down to a point 50 yards below Soda Springs Power Plant.

Umpqua River (North Fork) and Tributaries (exclusive of lakes) closed to angling in any manner other than with an artificial fly from the presently established winter deadline near the mouth of Rock Creek upstream to a point 50 yards below Soda Springs Power Plant.

Umpqua River (South Fork) closed to all angling from a point 100 yards above to a point 150 yards below the South Umpqua Falls.

Applegate River closed to angling from any boat or other float-

ing device.

Big Butte Creek closed to all angling from a point 100 yards below the lower fish racks to a point 100 yards above the upper racks.

Fish Lake closed to angling within a 50 foot radius of the windmill.

Illinois River is closed to all angling from Fall Creek to a point 60 feet above Illinois Falls.

Rogue River is closed to all angling in the following portions:

1. 100 yards above and below any tagging trap or fish rack.

2. From Rainey Falls to a point 400 feet below.

3. From Savage Rapids Dam to a point 400 feet below.

4. From Gold Ray Dam to a point 550 feet below Copco Gold Ray bridge from January 1 to August 31; and to a point 550 feet below said bridge from September 1 to December 31.

5. From a point 300 feet above the upper end of diversion dam of the Beaver-Portland Cement Company's powerhouse to a point 500 feet below the lower side of the junction of the tailrace from the powerhouse and main channel of the Rogue River, including the canal.

6. From Gold Hill Irrigation District spillway to a point 700 feet upstream from January 1 to July 15.

Rogue River above Bybee bridge is closed to angling from or having assembled fishing tackle in or on any boat or floating device from July 1 to December 31.

Squaw Lakes, exclusive of tributaries, open April 25 to October 18.

Willow Creek Reservoir, exclusive of tributaries, open April 25 to October 18.

Zone 5

Lake Boat and Motor Regulations Closed to use of motor boats for any purpose; Badger, Devils, Frog (Wasco County), Horseshoe (Jefferson County), Irish, North Twin (Deschutes County), Olallie, South Twin (Deschutes County), Taylor and Three Creeks lakes.

Closed to operation of motor boats at a speed over 10 mile per hour during those hours and days lawful to fish: Crescent, Davis, East, Elk, Paulina lakes and Pelton Reservoir (Lake Simustus).

Closed to fishing from motor propelled craft: Menon Lake (Jefferson County), Rock Creek Reservoir (Wasco County), and Walton Lake (Crook County).

Special Regulations and Closures Blue Lake (Jefferson County) is open April 25 to October 18.

Chepoweth Creek (Wasco County) is open to trout angling the entire year. (Summer bag limit).

Columbia River closed to all angling from upstream side of the interstate highway bridge at The Dalles to the upper line of The Dalles Dam.

Columbia River—Waters of The Dalles impoundment closed to angling from or on any boat or floating device above Highway 30 bridge at mouth of the Deschutes River.

Crescent Lake is open April 25 to October 18.

Davis Lake is closed to angling in any other manner than with an artificial fly.

Deschutes River is closed to all angling in the following portions:

1. From Crane Prairie dam down to Sheep bridge forest camp, a distance of about two miles.

2. From Wickiup dam down to a point one-fourth mile below.

3. From Portland General Electric re-regulating dam downstream to the fish trap, a distance of about 450 feet.

Deschutes River and tributaries from Little Lava Lake down to Cow Camp bridge are open to angling with artificial flies only and are closed to angling from or on any boat or floating device.

Deschutes River and tributaries below Bend are closed to fishing from or having assembled fishing tackle in or on any boat or floating device.

East Lake is open May 30 to October 3.

Fifteenmile Creek (Wasco County) is closed to all angling from a point 200 feet above the fishway at Seufert dam down to its mouth.

Haystack Reservoir open entire year.

Link Creek, tributary to Suttle Lake, is closed to all angling.

Lucky Lake (Deschutes County) is closed to all angling.

Metolus River and its tributaries

are closed to all angling from the source to Lake Creek. (Does not include Lake Creek.)

Metolus River is closed to all angling for a distance of approximately 100 feet above and below Camp Sherman bridge as designated by markers of the Game Commission.

Metolus River and its tributaries, closed to all chinook salmon angling.

Metolus River is closed to angling in any other manner than with an artificial fly from Lake Creek down to bridge 99 on the river loop road.

Mill Creek, tributary to Columbia River, (Wasco County) from the forks down to its mouth is open to trout angling entire year. (Summer bag limit.)

Mud Lake and tributaries are closed to all angling.

Ochoco Reservoir is open entire year.

Odell Lake is open April 25 to October 18.

Odell Lake bag limit for trout 30 inches or over in length is two fish per day and four in possession or in seven consecutive days and is to be counted with and as part of the general trout bag limit.

Paulina Lake is open May 30 to October 3.

Paulina Lake is closed to all angling in that portion from the dam to a line starting from a point 400 yards north of the Paulina Lake Resort powerhouse, extending diagonally across the lake to a marker 300 yards north of the boat dock in the Forest Service campgrounds.

Rock Creek Reservoir (Wasco County) is open April 25 to October 18.

South Twin Lake chumming permitted.

Sparks Lake closed to angling from any craft while such craft is being propelled by a motor.

Sparks Lake and Tributaries closed to angling in any other manner than with an artificial fly.

Squaw Creek, tributary of Deschutes River, is closed to all angling from Camp Polk road bridge down to its mouth.

Suttle Lake is open from April 25 to October 18, except that part within a radius of 100 yards of the mouth of Link Creek is closed to angling from September 15 to October 18.

Todd Lake is closed to the use of motor boats for any purpose, and is closed to angling from or on any boat or floating device.

Wickiup Reservoir is open April 25 to October 18.

Zone 6

Special Regulations and Closures

Blue Lake is closed to angling from or having assembled fishing tackle in any gas-propelled boat.

Campbell Lake is closed to angling from or having assembled fishing tackle in any gas-propelled boat.

Crump Lake is open to trout angling entire year. (Summer bag limit prevails.)

Deadhorse Lake is closed to angling from or having assembled fishing tackle in any gas-propelled boat.

Devils Lake closed to angling from any motor-propelled boat.

Dog Lake is open to trout angling entire year. (Summer bag limit prevails.)

Drews Creek and tributaries above Drews Reservoir are closed to all angling.

Drews Reservoir is open to trout angling entire year. (Summer bag limit prevails.)

Ewauna Lake (Klamath County) is open to trout angling entire year. (Summer bag limit prevails.)

Hart Lake is open to trout angling entire year. (Summer bag limit prevails.)

Klamath River is open to trout angling except from June 15 to September 30.

Klamath River close to angling from Copco Big Bend dam to flume crossing.

Lake of the Woods open April 25 to October 18.

Link River is open to trout angling entire year. (Summer bag limit prevails.)

Lofton Reservoir is open to angling the entire year but is closed to angling from any motor-propelled boat. (Summer bag limit prevails.)

Lost River is open to trout angling entire year. (Summer bag

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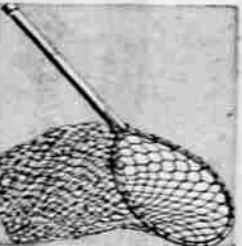
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
