Spencer Creek and tributaries open to angling July 1 to October 31.

Spring Creek from its mouth to a point 100 yards upstream is open to trout angling from May 30 to October 31.

Upper Klamath Lake south of a line from Modoc Point to the northern-most point of Eagle Ridge, exclusive of Shoalwater Bay, open to trout angling entire year. (Summer bag limit prevails.)

Williamson River, exclusive of tributaries except as provided above, is open to trout angling from May 30 to October 31.

Williamson River is closed to angling from or on any boat or floating device above Highway 97 bridge.

Wood River is open from May 30 to October 31.

#### Zone 7

**Special Regulations and Closures**  
Stream or Stream Sections not listed below as open to steelhead and salmon angling are closed to such angling the entire year, including all tributaries unless specifically listed.

Steelhead and salmon angling will be closed on and between all closure dates listed for Zone 7.

Columbia River and its tributaries are closed to all salmon angling, including jack salmon, November 1 through November 30, page 29.

Trout bag limit in all waters: Ten fish six inches and over in length in any one day and 20 in possession; except no minimum length on eastern brook trout. Dolly Varden trout are to be included in and with the regular summer trout bag limit. When trout season is closed, bag limit for Dolly Varden is 10 fish per day, 20 in possession or in seven consecutive days with no length limit in waters open to steelhead and salmon angling.

Columbia River is open to steelhead and salmon angling entire year.

Columbia River closed to angling from McNary Dam downstream to a line across the river from Government Ferry landing on the Oregon shore to red and white markers on the Washington shore.

John Day River below Indian Creek is open to steelhead and salmon angling except from April 25 to June 30.

John Day River closed to angling from 200 feet below to 200 feet above Canyon Creek.

John Day River (Middle Fork) below Sunshine Guard Station is open to steelhead and salmon angling except from April 25 to June 30.

John Day River (North Fork) below Highway 395 is open to steelhead and salmon angling except from April 25 to June 30.

McKay Reservoir special bag limit of 30 fish per day, 60 in possession or in seven consecutive days.

Mill Creek open to trout angling May 17 to September 15.

Slide and Upper Slide Lakes open to angling May 30 to October 31.

Strawberry and Little Strawberry Lakes open to angling May 30 to October 31.

Umatilla River is closed to all angling for a distance of 300 feet below the Three Mile dam and 300 feet below the Cold Springs intake dam, and in the Westland canal from the point of diversion to the fish screen and from the fish screen to a point 100 feet down the by-pass ditch.

Umatilla River below Mission bridge is open to steelhead and salmon angling except from April 1 to November 30.

Walla Walla River is closed to all angling for a distance of 300 feet below Hudson Bay dam and 300 feet below the Little Walla Walla intake dam.

Walla Walla River below confluence of north and south forks is open to steelhead and salmon angling except from April 1 to November 30.

Walla Walla River below confluence of north and south forks is open to steelhead and salmon angling except from April 1 to November 30.

Walla Walla River, Little, is closed to all angling from the point of diversion to a point 140 feet below the fish screen.

Walla Walla River (North Fork) and tributaries are open to trout

angling from April 25 to June 30.

#### Zone 8

**Special Regulations and Closures**  
Trout bag limit in all waters: 10 fish six inches and over in length in any one day and 20 in possession unless otherwise specified.

Antelope Reservoir is open to trout angling entire year.

Baca Lake is closed to all angling.

Beulah Reservoir open to angling entire year.

Blitzen River, exclusive of tributaries, is closed to all angling from the mouth of Bridge Creek to Malheur Lake.

Chickahominy Reservoir open to angling entire year. (Summer bag limit prevails.)

Delintment Lake open to angling entire year.

Eastside Canal is closed to all angling from point where Bridge Creek enters canal to Baca Lake.

High Lake open to angling May 30 to October 18.

High Lake (Grant County) bag limit for eastern brook trout is 30 per day, 60 in possession, and no minimum length limit.

Krumbo Reservoir and Krumbo Creek open to angling July 1 to September 30.

Mud and Little Mud Lakes open to angling May 30 to October 18.

Owyhee River is closed to all angling for a distance of 150 yards below dam.

Owyhee Lake is open the entire year.

Warm Springs Reservoir is open entire year.

#### Zone 9

**Special Regulations and Closures**  
Streams or Stream Sections not listed below as open to steelhead and salmon angling are closed entire year to such angling, including all tributaries unless specifically listed.

Steelhead and salmon angling will be closed on and between all closure dates listed for Zone 9.

Columbia River and its tributaries are closed to all salmon angling, including jack salmon, November 1 through November 30.

Trout bag limit in all waters: 10 fish, six inches and over in length in any one day and 20 in possession unless otherwise specified. No minimum length on eastern brook trout. Dolly Varden trout are to be included in and with the regular summer trout bag limit. When trout season is closed, bag limit for Dolly Varden is 10 fish per day, 20 in possession or in seven consecutive days with no length limit in waters open to salmon and steelhead angling.

Camp Creek and tributaries above Higgins Reservoir are closed to all angling.

Catherine Creek (Union County) is closed to all angling 500 feet above and below the dam and spillway of the city of Union water intake, and from the upper Davis Dam to a point 200 yards below the lower Davis Dam.

Catherine Creek below the city of Union water intake is open to steelhead and salmon angling except from June 20 to December 31.

Eagle Creek below the bridge at Newbridge open to salmon and steelhead angling except from April 29 to August 31.

Elkhorn Mountain Lakes and their tributaries in Grant and Baker counties, except Anthony, Grande Ronde and Mud lakes, are open entire year to angling with a daily bag limit of 30 fish of which not more than 10 singly or in the aggregate may be golden, rainbow, cutthroat or lake trout, and possession of 60 of which not more than 20 singly or in the aggregate may be golden, rainbow, cutthroat or lake trout.

Grande Ronde River below the bridge at Beaver Creek is open to salmon and steelhead angling except from April 10 to June 1.

Imnaha River below Freezeout bridge is open to salmon and steelhead angling except from April 10 to June 1.

Minam River below Cougar Creek is open to salmon and steelhead angling except from April 10 to June 1.

Murray Reservoir is closed to angling from a boat or other floating device.

Pine Creek below the north fork is open to salmon and steelhead angling except from April 29 to August 31.

Powder River below Thief Valley Dam is open to salmon and steelhead angling except from

April 29 to August 31.

Snake River is open to steelhead and salmon angling entire year except that portion from the marker 100 feet above the upstream bank of Pine Creek to the face of Oxbow Dam is closed to all angling.

Wallowa Mountain Lakes and their tributaries above 5,000 feet elevation, except Duck, Twin and Fish lakes, are open entire year to angling with a daily bag limit of 30 fish of which not more than 10 singly or in the aggregate may be golden, rainbow, cutthroat or lake trout, and possession of 60 of which not more than 20 singly or in the aggregate may be golden, rainbow, cutthroat or lake trout.

Wallowa Lake is open April 25 to November 30, except that season for yanks is open April 25 to August 31; provided that the part of Wallowa Lake at the head of the lake is closed to all angling south of markers established by the Game Commission. Bag limit for yanks is 10 fish a day, 20 in possession, but said bag limit is to be counted with and a part of the general bag limit for trout.

Wallowa River is closed to angling entire year from head of Wallowa Lake to the falls on the

West Fork and to the PPL intake on the East Fork.

Wallowa River below Lostine River is open to steelhead and salmon angling except from April 10 to June 1.

Wenaha River below Crooked Creek is open to angling for steelhead and salmon except from April 10 to June 1.

#### WINTER REGULATIONS

##### All Dates Inclusive

Zone 1—February 7 to February 28, 1959, and November 1, 1959, to February 28, 1960.

Zones 2, 5, 6 and 8—February 7 to April 24, 1959, and November 1, 1959, to April 23, 1960.

Exceptions and closures are listed in alphabetical order by zone. Whitefish may be taken from any water when it is open to trout, steelhead or salmon angling. No bag or length limit.

##### COLUMBIA RIVER

The bag limit on the Columbia River in all zones from February 7 to April 24, 1959, and November 1, 1959, to April 23, 1960, is two fish per day, 12 inches or over in length, and four such fish in seven consecutive days or in possession. (Closed to all salmon fishing during November.)

##### Zone 1

Winter Season: February 7 to February 28, 1959, and November

1, 1959, to February 28, 1960. The Columbia River and its tributaries are closed to all salmon angling, including Jack salmon, November 1 through November 30.

Bag Limit: Trout, jack salmon, steelhead and salmon 12 inches and over: two fish per day and four such fish in possession or in seven consecutive days.

A special bag limit of four such fish per day, of which not more than two may be trout or steelhead and eight fish, of which not more than four may be trout or steelhead, in possession or in seven consecutive days applies to the Tenmile Lakes and Tenmile Creek, outlet of Tenmile Lakes, Coos County.

A separate Jack salmon bag limit of 10 per day and 20 in seven consecutive days applies from October 1 to November 15, inclusive.

Open Waters: All waters listed below. Tributary streams are closed unless listed.

Alsea River. Extended season March 1 to 31. Winter bag limit applies.

Alsea River (North Fork) up to highway bridge crossing below
