Sport Pilots Chat Safety

Flight complications which might arise at Kingsley Field in the operation of civilian aircraft and Air Force jets, and safety precautions were on the discussion agenda Tuesday night during a joint meeting of the Klamath Falls Chapter, Sportsmen Pilots of Oregon, host group, representatives of the Federal Aviation Agency (FAA) and Kingsley Field Air Force personnel. The well-attended meeting was held in the Officers Club on the base.

Col. Jack W. Williams, Kingsley Field base commander, reiterated Air Force intention to cooperate at all times with pilots of civilian aircraft and sought reciprocal civilian use of the field.

He explained importance of flying missions, unscheduled alerts and urged care in takeoffs and landings.

Information on civilian use of the field under the new control tower will be distributed to distant points for pilots of small aircraft.

The meeting was the first of a series to be held on problems of joint use of the flying field.

J. L. Kennedy, communications department of FAA, Los Angeles, was an all-day visitor in Klamath Falls Tuesday, meeting with officials of the municipal airport, the U.S. Air Force and city officials.

Revision Slated In Fuel Laws

Drivers who use fuel other than gasoline in their vehicles will soon be able to buy diesel fuel, liquid gas and so forth without having to file a monthly tax report with the Department of Motor Vehicles.

The change is a result of a new law passed by the Legislature. It will go into effect May 1. The law provides that dealers shall collect the six cents per gallon tax instead of vehicle owners.

But purchasers of non-gasoline fuels are still required to get special permits, and they must obtain permission to discontinue filing monthly tax reports if all the fuel they use is purchased, tax-paid, from licensed dealers.
