Bids will be for the construction of an addition to the Klamath County Nursing Home, Klamath Falls, Oregon. The addition will cover a ground area of approximately 462 square feet. General bids are requested which will include all items of work necessary to complete the project. Exterior wall of building will be clay tile with brick veneer, windows of wood, interior wood frame with plaster walls and ceilings; floors, concrete; roof, wood frame with clay tile roofing; heating by steam; lighting is incandescent.
