Woman Leader Apaches' First

MESCALERO, N.M. (AP)—For the first time in the known history of the Mescalero Apaches, a woman has become tribal sachem.

Amiable Mrs. Virginia Klinekole this year became the first woman president of the Apache Tribe of the Mescalero Reservation.

Mrs. Klinekole, serving a one-year term, is a native of the reservation and has lived on it all her life with the exception of years spent away at school at Haskell Institute in Lawrence, Kansas. Her husband is a rancher in Three Rivers village and they have three children.

"I was greatly surprised upon being elected president," said Mrs. Klinekole. "I am greatly honored that my people hold me worthy of this position."

Mrs. Klinekole is not what most people think of as an "Indian chief." Among most New Mexican Indians, the "chief" was a leader whose power came from his skill in war. There is no modern counterpart.

The Mescalero tribe consists of about 800 Mescaleros, about 400 Chiricahuas and a few Lipans. The majority speak and read English but all can speak the native Apache tongue.

NEW YORK (NEA)—The shimmering colors of the air and the shifting colors of the sea are reflected in swimsuits the girls will be wearing this summer.

The gleam of pink, the reflection of sunny yellow, the foaming green-blue of the sea itself will lend their own particular radiance to the beaches of this country. For most designers feel that these brilliant shadings are best in keeping with colors produced by nature.

Sleek, one-piece swimsuits will, despite the bikini talk, be the choice of most girls. There's a suit designer's have put years of trial-and-error into producing suits that do the most in streamlining a figure. They have turned out suits with built-in bras and girdles that can smooth out lumps, make a waist look smaller and even conceal heavy thighs.

Sheer curtains should be lightly starched. Not only will they hang better but they will resist dust.

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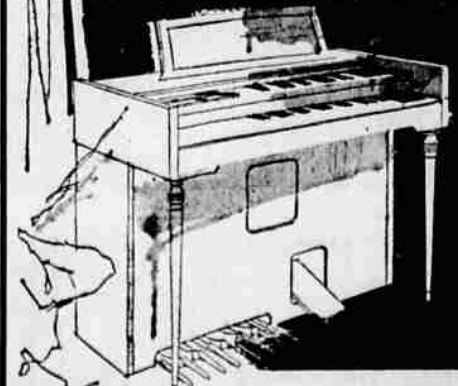
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
