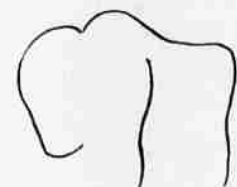

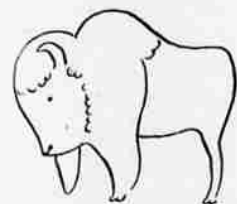

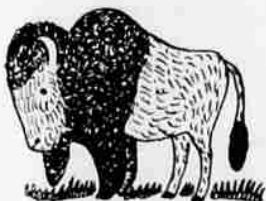
Gone are the days of long ago

Stick, Stone, or Shell Hop

Here is a more strenuous form of hopscotch, because it involves almost continuous hopping. Lay 10 sticks, large stones, or big clam shells in a row about one foot apart. To play, you hop on one foot over each stick, stone, or shell until the last one is cleared. Then, still on one foot, pick up the 10th stick and hop back to the starting place with it, still hopping over the objects left on the ground. If this is done without touching a stick or touching the ground with the other foot, you repeat the trip, collecting at the end the ninth stick; continue, if you can, until all the sticks are picked up. If a player misses, the next one takes over and hops till he misses.
