Recreation Plays Big Part In Plans For Forests Of Nation In USFS Control

Wherever you live, wherever you may be, whether it is in a tenement flat in a clanging city, along a dusty farm road, or at the edge of the scorching desert, there is always a National Forest nearby inviting you to its cool green forests, mountain lakes and valley streams.

For a few hours, a day or so, you can become released from time. Imagine having no need for a watch, having no appointments nor schedules. There is no hurry, for as each square mile of the many thousands is rich in interest, why rush anywhere?

National forest land is open for relaxing outdoor recreation. Restrictions are imposed only when necessary for your health and safety and for protection of the forests. Hunting, fishing, picnicking, hiking, skiing and camping are some of the wholesome activities enjoyed by forest visitors.

Many fishermen try their luck in the streams and lake which are abundant in trout and which also offer resting grounds for ducks and geese, providing good hunting for those who come from all over the West.

Within the forest are campgrounds for the convenience and enjoyment of forest users. Camping is not restricted to established camps but is allowed to anywhere in the forest unless particular areas are closed because of fire danger. Camps and picnic grounds are usually provided with rustic tables, fireplaces and sanitation facilities. Visitors using a camp or other areas are requested to leave a clean camp and a dead fire.

In the higher mountainous areas there are peaks for climbing, trails for hiking along the skyline and fishing in the well stocked streams and lakes. Along forest highways, but more especially on large lakes, there are places of recreation for all. In addition to camp grounds, there are organizational camps where youth groups, churches and many others enjoy planned recreation. There are public boat landings for water skiing, fishing and canoeing, and there are beaches for swimming and skin diving. Parts of the forest are set aside for summer home sites along lake shores, streams or near huping areas. Nearly everywhere in the national forest, there is a place where you can make your time off into leisure time.

There are many interesting ge-

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ological formations in and near the forest. Remnants of the ice age and of unknown people can be found near ancient volcanic areas. While Indian arrowheads, knives, bowls and tools are discovered more readily along the ancient lakeshores, relics of an earlier age are also found. Greater rewards however are just to walk the paths worn smooth by moccasined feet centuries ago, or to imagine the noiseless dip, dip of an ancient canoe paddle as you wade the shallow shores.

Forest roads provide excellent touring and access to all these areas. While driving along a forest road which was once an old covered wagon route, one will always find remnants of those earlier days. Some small prospectors' cabins, an old schoolhouse, or a little deserted farm back in a secluded spot will start the imagination. An ox yoke, or a cast flat iron from Philadelphia are but trifles compared with what one may find along these forest roads. Then, one may tour on to large open slopes for berry picking, or just hike to enjoy the solitude of a wilderness area. You never think of being isolated here. How could you be lonely? You meet many new animal friends all of the time.

Not only in the summer is the national forest adaptable to a wide range of recreational activities. You will be astonished at the great beauty of the forest in winter. One may enjoy hiking along a

snow-shoe trail or cross country skiing. At large developed areas, there are ski lifts and powdery slopes that provide excellent sport. Recreation is an important source of the forest. All uses of national forests are handled under a coordinated plan of management known as multiple use. Multiple use means that almost all of the National Forest areas yield not one but several different products or services at the same time. Thus harvesting, live-stock grazing, various uses of water, mining, hunting and fishing, berry picking and similar activities may take place at the same time by so adjusting each that it does not measurably interfere with the others.

These are some of the reasons why we must conserve and keep unspoiled our national forests. They are a unique treasure which we trust fervently may be served for the generations to come.
