Mira - Base

Basic grooming routines, such as weekly shampoo, daily skin cleansing, showering and bathing, are second nature. But these are not enough for complete grooming perfection. To be at our best, constant attention must be given to those extras that make our appearance worthy of mention.

For example, the care of the hands and nails. Some women seem to think that a slapdash application of nail polish, sometimes over a chipped original application, is all that is necessary. As one woman was heard to comment, "I just want some color on my nails." This is not enough. For hands and nails to look their lovely best there are certain "musts" for their daily and weekly care.

Nail polish is only the visible part of nail grooming and there are other just as important steps. For example, proper filing, cuticle care and, of course, we must never forget the day and night use of a good lubricating hand cream.

One of the most important invisible steps in the manicure procedure is the application of a good base coat as a foundation for the color. A good foundation will aid in disguising nail irregularities as well as lengthen polish wear. Now, Cutex has come up with a new base coat called Mira-Base. This is really a fascinating product. It brushes on like a dream and there is no need to wait for it to dry... follow immediately with polish application. What a time saver! Also, Mira-Base will double ordinary polish wear. A boon for those people who have trouble keeping polish on their nails.

At the risk of being repetitious, we are listing briefly the steps to a professional manicure that can be easily done at home:

A. Begin by removing old polish from your nails. Hold a ball of cotton moistened with Cutex Oily Polish Remover on the nail for a few seconds. Smooth toward nail tip. This polish remover is guaranteed not to contain acetone or any other harsh ingredients that dry the nails.

B. Shape nail with an emery board. Use the coarse side to file from side to center. Do not file too closely at the sides as this weakens the support of the nail and may cause breakage. Bevel edges with the fine side of the Emery Board.

C. Remove dead tissue around sides and base of nails with a cotton-tipped orangewood stick moistened with Cutex Oily Cuticle

Remover. Wipe away the loosened tissue with a towel. Do not cut cuticle. Bleach nail tips with moistened nail white pencil. Wipe nails clean with cotton moistened with Oily Polish Remover.

D. Brush Mira-Base over entire nail. No need to wait for this base coat to dry.
E. Follow immediately with your choice of polish color. Apply with a light quick brush stroke down each side of nail and a final stroke down the center. Remove a thin hairline of polish from the tip of each nail with the ball of the thumb. Perhaps you would like to try one of the new exotic shades of Cutex Pearl Polish — Capri Blue, Jamaica Green, Tahiti Orchid, Coral Sand, Hot Pink, Mint Green. Match a shade to your costume or jewelry.

F. With light quick strokes flow on Cutex Overcoat. This is a colorless liquid that dries rapidly and adds extra, extra gloss as well as additional days of wear. May be applied between manicures if polish begins to look a little dull.

CANDLES
A bent candle may be straightened by hanging it in a warm place. Tie one end of a string to the wick and the other end to the crossbar of a coat hanger.

FLOWER ARRANGEMENTS
Flowers love light, so it is a good idea to turn a vase of flowers once a day to keep the flowers from turning all in one direction toward the source of light.

"Sales of major appliances were helped considerably by the Klamath Basin Home Show this year," was the statement of Vern Owens, of Cascade Home Furnishings.

"The idea that a refrigerator could have no frost, automatically, is a little hard to explain unless a person really sees it," he commented. "Frost-proof to most persons means automatic defrosting but Frigidaire has gone a long ways beyond that."

SALAD ROUNDS

Interestingly seasoned cottage cheese tops slices of tomato aspic in "Spring Salad Rounds." Onion, seasoned salt and thin radish slices stirred into cottage cheese makes this popular salad ingredient exciting. The delicate flavor of the cheese isn't spoiled by the addition of onion because instant minced onion is extremely mild and sweet. Taste a few of the crisp bits as they come from the container and see for yourself.

- SPRING SALAD ROUNDS**
- 1 tablespoon instant minced onion
 - 1 tablespoon water
 - 1½ cups cottage cheese
 - ¾ teaspoon seasoned salt
 - 2 or 3 radishes
 - 1 (13½-ounce) can tomato aspic
 - Shredded lettuce
 - French dressing
- Stir instant minced onion into water; let stand a few minutes. Combine onion with cottage cheese, salt and thinly sliced radishes. Cut tomato aspic into 6 slices and arrange on bed of shredded lettuce drizzled with a little French dressing. Top each aspic round with a spoonful of cottage cheese mixture. Makes 6 servings.

SPARES
When buying buttons for garments you are sewing at home, it is always a good idea to buy an extra one or two to match.

FISH FILLETS
Add minced chives and parsley in butter and use for fish fillets you are skillet cooking or baking.

SPINACH
Crisply-cooked crumbled bacon over the top of cooked spinach, snap beans or sweet potatoes gives these vegetables a lift.

STEW
Have meat cut in large chunks for stew and brown it carefully over slow heat before adding moisture for a more beautiful stew.

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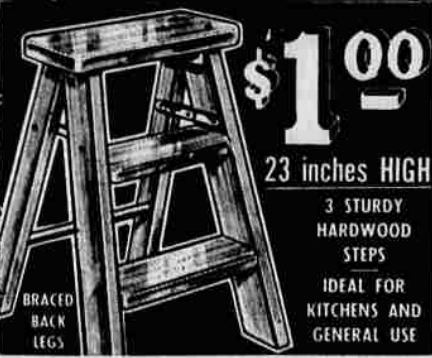
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
