Mayo Clinic Keeps Busy

ROCHESTER, Minn. (UPI) — Mayo Clinic, the famous medical haven for thousands of the rich and famous, is a busier place now than it ever was in the days of the Mayo brothers.

Last year, registration hit an all-time high of 139,541, more than 3,000 greater than in record-breaking 1957.

Clinic officials say patients flock to the diagnostic center from all over the world, but that most of them are from a 500-mile radius around Rochester.

Officials say the reasons for the increased use of the clinic are more families with health insurance, the growth in population and a general upswing in the economy.

Coffee Break Still Gains

WILLOW GROVE, Pa. (UPI) — The "coffee break" not only has become generally accepted in U.S. business operations, according to a recent survey, but more often than not there's more than one a day.

The National Office Management Association surveyed nearly 2,000 firms in the U.S. and Canada, it reports, and found that coffee breaks in the working day, most of them now permit two one in the morning and one in the afternoon, normally of 15 minutes each.

Western America is more generous with coffee breaks than the East, the survey showed. In the West, 93 per cent of businesses checked allow two breaks; the Canadian average was 80 per cent.

For all firms checked in Canada and this country, the average was 81 per cent with regularly scheduled breaks. Fourteen per cent of the employers said they allowed workers to have coffee or other refreshment on a non-scheduled basis.

Major benefit reported: the breaks served as morale boosters. Major complaint: Workers did not get back to work promptly afterwards.
