Businessman Kills Wife, Police Chief; Suicides

LIMERICK, Maine (AP)—A less seriously wounded on both arms and abdomen. The scene of the blistering shooting was a quiet Maine crossroads settlement by an old mill pond about a mile from the center of Limerick, a village of 1,000 population 30 miles west of Portland.

Witnesses and police pieced together this story: At 4:15 p.m. as Rose Hamlin crossed the street to visit Mrs. Jessie Mitchell, Hamlin shouted to her from his front door and fired once with a rifle.

As Mrs. Hamlin raced up the front steps of the Mitchell home, Hamlin fired again and his wife fell mortally wounded on the porch.

Trooper Parker, the first to arrive at the scene, kicked open the front door of Hamlin's home. "He greeted me with both barrels of the gun," Parker said.

Although wounded, Parker radioed for reinforcements and stayed to assist arriving troopers, city police and game wardens.

The officers stationed themselves behind their cruisers and in houses on each side of Hamlin's home, firing with rifles and pistols.

They could see Hamlin from time to time ducking from one window to another as he fired his shotgun.

Harnois, a former FBI agent and Westbrook's first full-time police chief, was killed as he raced toward the house with a tear gas bomb in his hand.

Regina was shot as he approached the house from the opposite side.

Both lay sprawled on the lawn for nearly an hour before troopers could drag them out of range.

Medical Examiner Stephen A. Cobb said Hamlin had time to put the shotgun on a shelf before he slumped dead in several inches of water.

Also dead were Hamlin's wife, Rose, 46, and Westbrook Police Chief Pierre Harnois, 34, both killed by shotgun and rifle fire.

Slate Trooper Stephen A. Regina, 42, of Saco, was critically wounded by Hamlin's shotgun in the stomach and leg. His name is on the danger list in a Portland hospital.

Trooper Willard Parker was also wounded.

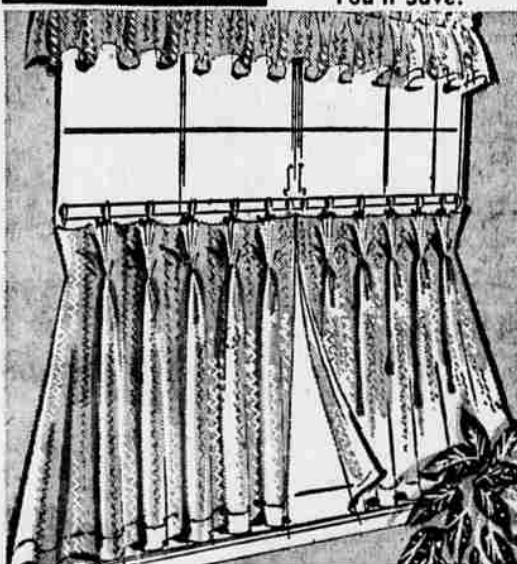

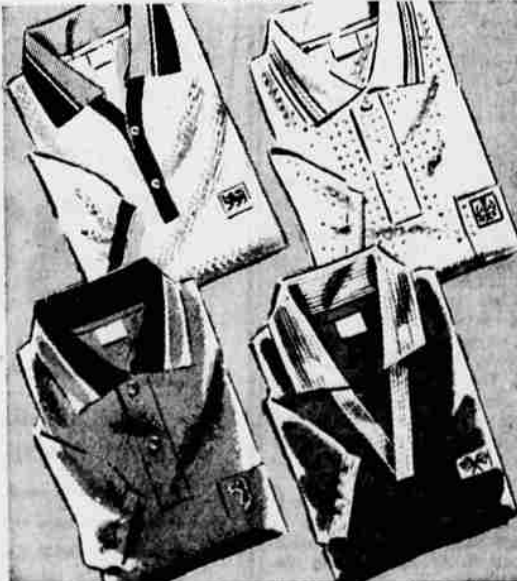
