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Celebration Of Centennial Brings Back Many Stories

SALEM (AP)—Oregon's centennial celebration brings out all kinds of stories—of wagon trains, of Indian raids and, for the later arrivals, the smoke-puffing "iron horse" that chugged along the ribbons of steel that spanned America.

For Mrs. Louise Humphrey, the coming of the Iron Horse is more than a story; it is a memory that remains clear after three quarters of a century.

Mrs. Humphrey is 88 years old now. She lives with her daughter, Mrs. E. L. Herrell, in the Eola area west of here.

She's a spy 88, too, and her keen mind harkens back to 1883 when she and her family were passengers on what is believed the first immigrant train ever to make the 12-day trip west from St. Paul on the Northern Pacific line.

It was on Oct. 2, 1883, that her mother bundled Leanne Welch and her two sisters aboard the train.

Only a few days earlier, railroad tycoon Henry Villard and ex-President Ulysses S. Grant, had driven the golden spike that completed the line in ceremonies near Garrison, Mont.

Mrs. Humphrey recalls that the two men, on their way back East, left their elegant private coaches to visit the west-bound immigrant

train on which her family was riding. She recalls that both Grant and Villard entered the car and shook hands with the passengers. The train on which she rode consisted of 24 cars. Two were passenger cars, the other 22 carried freight.

One car was used for the immigrants from Europe. The other carried English-speaking passengers. There were about 35 passengers in each of the coaches. At one end was a big coal-burning range. On this the passengers cooked their own food.

They slept at night in their own blankets on hard, swing-down bunks.

The odors of frying beef and baking bread permeated the American coach. Garlic predominated in the other.

Each car had a broom and a dustpan. Sweeping up was the passengers' chore. An old fiddler and a Presbyterian minister, both passengers, cared for cultural and spiritual needs of the other passengers.

Leanne Welch and her family left the train at Spokane. She married and she and her husband reared their family in Oregon.

And although she has given up most traveling now, Mrs. Humphrey looks back on two memorable train trips: That as a pioneer on the rails in 1883 and another 12 years ago. In that latter year she retraced the route of the earlier trip, but in airconditioned, comfortable style.

And the railroad, because she had been a passenger on its first regularly scheduled passenger train west, gave her an escorted-and-free-tour of the Midwest.
