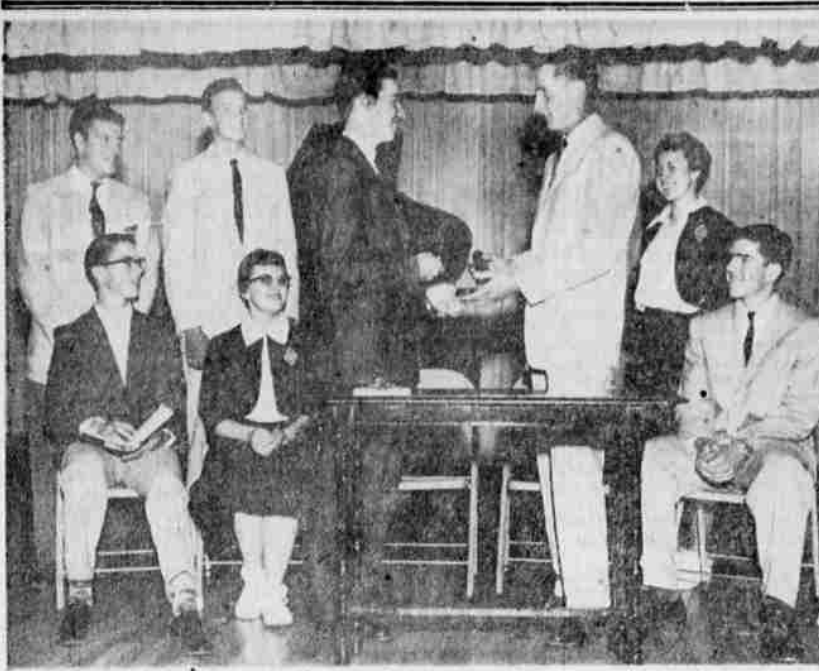

WASHINGTON — A half-century of service to the military was marked here May 1 as Walter Reed Army Hospital celebrates its Golden Anniversary.

Known the world over as the hospital where statesmen go for surgery and recovery, "Walter Reed" remains fresh in the memory of thousands of soldiers and airmen who have recovered there from almost every type of disease, wound or injury to beset mankind.

Named for Major Walter Reed, "the man who made the Panama Canal possible" through his research and discoveries with yellow fever, the hospital came into being May 1, 1909, as Walter Reed
