Savage Caters To Lefty Shooter With New Rifle

The first left-hand rifle ever offered southpaw hunters has been introduced by Savage. A combination varmint and big game rifle, it is made in .243, .270, .308 and .30-06 calibers.

People who are naturally left-handed have, up to now, had just three choices: learning to shoot right-handed; using a pump, lever or auto-loading rifle; or doing a contortionist act by operating the standard bolt from the left shoulder. It is estimated that perhaps a million hunters face this problem now.

Like the mythical left-handed monkey wrench, left-handed hunting rifles have never before been made by any major arms producer. Some custom gunsmiths, however, have catered to the market by converting standard rifles to left-hand operation. Because the conversion is a difficult one, custom jobs are very costly and require the additional expense of restocking. Thanks to mass production, the new rifle has a small purse-bite, only a few dollars more than the standard right-hand model.

Learning to shoot right-handed is no more easy for a southpaw

than for Warren Spahn to throw like Bob Turley. Furthermore, some right-handed persons have a master left eye resulting in a natural tendency to want to shoot from the right shoulder using the left eye. In fact, a few rifles have been custom stocked for this purpose. Their only solution is to learn to shoot from the left shoulder, thus forcing them to become southpaws against natural inclinations.

Using a pump, lever or auto-loader also has some disadvantages. They usually eject empty cartridges past the nose of the lefty. Most have a right-hand safety which is very difficult to operate from the left side, and some are not adaptable to scopes. But, and likely this is the chief consideration, bolt action rifles are potentially more accurate, a vital factor when precise long-range shooting is required.

Operating a standard bolt action rifle from the left shoulder is usually awkward and cumbersome. Admittedly, however, some lefties have become very proficient by sliding the left hand across the rifle and hooking the bolt handle with the thumb. But

the use of a telescope sight makes this virtually impossible, and scopes are here to stay.

No matter how you look at it, southpaws have been left behind the barn door when it comes to rifles. This latest rifle, the left-hand one-ten, is going to win a lot of friends for its maker. Moreover, the hobbyist who wants to make his own stock can buy just the barreled action—either left or right-hand. These interesting developments represent a real effort to cater to a minority group which has always been ignored.

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How To Change Garage Into Smart Family Room

A relatively inexpensive way to add more living space to a cramped home is to convert the garage. New wood panelings make it a simple task to transform the unfinished interior into an area of handsome usefulness.

Grooved redwood panels are an excellent choice for creating an all-purpose room from the bare garage walls. This room wall covering is grooved to look like random spaced boards, but comes in easy-to-install four by eight foot panels.

Grooved redwood has a warm, rich texture that creates an ideal atmosphere for quiet family gatherings and relaxing social occasions.

Frances M. Baer, interior planner of Berkeley, California, used this "V" grooved redwood paneling to turn a garage into a restful all-purpose room for a small tract home in the San Francisco area.

The panels were installed quickly and easily over the exposed studs of the unfinished garage interior. The pressed grooves are spaced so they align with studs. Nailing can be concealed in the grooves.

In decorating the new room, Mrs. Baer used bright "fun" colors to complement the easy informality of the wood paneling. She selected a free standing metal fireplace in

red and covered the floor with a wool shag rug in burnt orange. Floor pillows were covered in a Mexican cotton fabric that picks up and accents these bright colors.

For the furniture Mrs. Baer selected a Danish design that is "scaled down" for comfortable use by both children and adults. The low furniture also serves to give the room a more spacious look. A round table in oak and hearth bench in oak and teak provide a complementary wood texture to the paneled walls.

Remodeling can be done at a minimum cost if care is used in the selection of materials. Good inexpensive materials and well designed but low cost furniture will give the remodeled room a luxury look. Simpson's "V" grooved redwood plywood paneling, for example, can be installed on the average 12 by 8 foot wall for approximately \$33.

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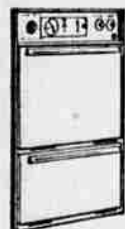
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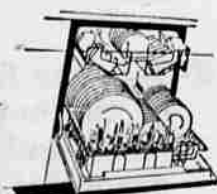
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
