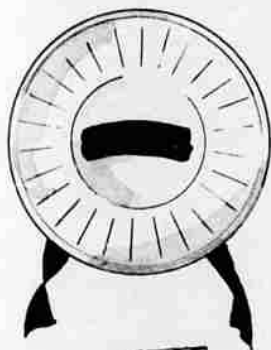

A Spring Hat for Your Doll!

Use a fluted paper baking cup to make an attractive coolie-style hat for an 8-inch doll. Lay the cup bottom up on a table and with the palm of your hand flatten it slightly. On opposite sides of the center circle (see sketch) cut $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch slits. Thread a 14-inch piece of narrow ribbon or yarn through these and pull the ribbon until it hangs down the same length on both sides. A bit of cellophane tape over each slit will keep the paper from tearing. Now put the hat on the doll's head and tie a bow under her chin.
