



LIBBY'S Spanish stuffed olives and Queen olives are being featured locally since Bill Riley has taken over that line to represent in the Klamath Basin area. The flat-topped, square-sided jars stack compactly and there are sizes convenient to use for any size family or party.

GREEN OLIVES

The Klamath Basin country is a great olive-eating area. There are probably more Wyandotte ripe olives, both pitted and unpitted, sold in the Klamath Basin than any other place in Oregon.

Libby's green olives are a companion food.

Green olives, of course, are what the name implies. The fruit has not been permitted to ripen before being processed for consumption.

Bill Riley, now with Ewel-Corner brokerage company, Portland, is representing Libby's in this area and he brought in the five jars of green olives shown here.

From left, there is the 4 1/2 ounce jar of imported Spanish Queen olives in the new space-saver jar, then the big one pound size jar of the same type of olives, the medium size jar holds 7 1/2 ounces of Spanish olives stuffed with pimientos; the big pound - jar and small 4 1/2-ounce jars are jumble

pack Spanish green olives stuffed with pimientos. The Spanish olives are imported and packed by Libby's in the United States.

You will not find imported ripe olives on the market because olives shipped in from Spain and other southern countries are picked green. According to the department of agriculture, olives cannot be allowed to ripen in the southern European countries because of the fruit fly which attacks the fruit as it ripens, making it unfit for packing. Because the green olives are still hard, the fruit fly leaves them alone.

PICKLED SHORT RIBS

For four servings, combine 1/2 cup chopped sweet mixed pickles, 1/2 cup sweet pickle liquid, 1/4 cup prepared mustard, 1/4 cup molasses and one tablespoon soy sauce. Mix well. Pour over two pounds beef short ribs and chill for two hours. Remove ribs. Broil short ribs three to four inches from source of heat, or cook on outdoor grill 10 to 15 minutes, or until browned on all sides. Brush short ribs with pickle mixture during cooking period.

BEAUTY TIP

Most women forget that eyelashes have two distinct surfaces—a top side and a bottom side. Give your lashes that luxurious look by applying make-up to the top of the lashes as well. Then, as you separate them, the make-up will naturally flow around the sides of each eyelash.

Finish, however, with the usual upward stroke, so the entire fringe will acquire the upward sweep. Encircle the bottom lashes, too.

BEAUTY SPOTS

Both change the intensity of the original lipstick shade to an opalescent pastel version; while Moon Lustre lightens and pearlizes the lipstick still further with its shimmering moon-lit finish. This pale lipstick had all started with the French and Italian women, who wear the transparent lustre-stick in place of their regular lipstick, to give the mouth a nude, color-subtle appearance. This summer, with a tan, American women will adapt this dramatic fashion in a more conservative manner, as they did with the bikini, by wearing the lustre-stick as a base and top coat along with regular lipstick. It's a fun fashion idea and a way to give new color dimension to your lipstick wardrobe.
