Annihilation Of Exiles Vowed By Nicaraguan

MANAGUA, Nicaragua (AP) — President Luis Somoza Monday night promised annihilation in two days of a two-paneleds of exile...

Somoza said the second wave—about 25 men flying in a plane stolen from the Costa Rican Air line—was "practically finished" soon after it landed near Matagalpa...

Rebel leader Enrique Lacayo Farfan declared in San Jose, Costa Rica, that a revolution had broken out against the Somoza dictatorship with fighting at several points.

The National Guard, Nicaragua's 3,200-man army, reported that air force planes attacked the second plane before it could be unloaded and it exploded.

Cleric Leads Village Rites

WUPPERTAL, Germany (AP) — A Nobel Prize-winning Belgian priest presided Sunday over ground-breaking ceremonies for a refugee village named for Anna Frank, the young Jewish girl whose diary became a World War II classic.

The Somoza brothers inherited a dynasty set up by their father, Anastasio Sr., in 1936 after the U. S. Marines withdrew from Nicaragua.

The darkness was almost pitch black off the coast of France when the anchor chain of our command ship, the Bayfield, rattled out on D-Day 15 years ago.

planes which was poised to attack the east coast of the Cherbourg peninsula. As Rear Adm. Don P. Moon, the naval commander of Task Force Utah, and I looked out from the bridge of the Bayfield, nothing could be seen of the hundreds of transports, LSTs, and smaller landing craft and accompanying naval escorts which we knew were all around us.

"Gens. Bradley and Kean, Adms. Kirk, Moon and Wiltse, several Brits and I were none too optimistic as we assembled last night (at British naval headquarters in Plymouth) for the word as to whether or not we would get under way again. It was with a mixture of relief and misgivings that we received the decision to go ahead, subject to final confirmation early this morning.
