KF Mission Addition Work Moving Ahead

Work is progressing rapidly on a new, three-story addition to the Klamath Falls Gospel Mission, 823 Walnut Avenue. Excavation of the basement area to be converted into a large kitchen at the rear of the present building has been accomplished with volunteer labor, offered by men who have been guests of the mission. This area will contain also large storage space, a walk in cooler and refrigeration area to the rear of the present dining room. A built in incinerator is in the plans. The second floor or floor on street level will be used for banquets and a reading room. Space on the top floor will provide 50-bed sleeping accommodations. The remodeling program will include lavatories and showers, barber shop, check room and clothing storage area. Above ground construction will be of pumice brick with 750 donated bricks already on hand. John Pederson, mission superintendent said there is \$1,200 in the building fund. Estimated cost of the addition is \$14,000. Many of the men visiting the mission are finding work in or near Klamath Falls and the mission is rapidly becoming an employment center. About 30 men now spend the night at the shelter, receiving two good meals.
