

Hawaii Man Gets Degree

CORVALLIS, Ore. (AP) — Oregon State College Monday presented an honorary doctor of science degree to Yasuo Baron Goto, who was born at sea as his parents immigrated from Japan to Hawaii.

At commencement exercises here, Dr. A. L. Strand, the college's president, cited Goto for his "unique capacity to advance the technical assistance program of the United States of America in the several countries of South-east Asia and wide recognition in the entire Pacific basin as ambassador of good will and scientific agriculture."

Goto is director of the Hawaiian Extension Service and the International Cooperation Center of Hawaii.

Another honorary doctor of science degree went to Wilfrid Johnson, general manager of the Hanford atomic products operations at Richland, Wash.

Solon Backs PNW Lawyer

WASHINGTON (AP) — Sen. Richard L. Neuberger (D-Ore) Monday endorsed the nomination of John F. Kilkenny to be U.S. district judge in Oregon.

Kilkenny, a Pendleton attorney, was nominated for the post by President Eisenhower last February. He would fill the vacancy created by the retirement of Judge Claude McCulloch.

A hearing on the nomination will be held by the Senate Judiciary Committee on Monday.

Meanwhile, in Portland, Ore., the Oregon Journal reported in a special dispatch from Washington that Sen. Morse (D-Ore) also had endorsed Kilkenny's nomination.

Advance Sale Figures Noted

This will solve the commission's major worry: getting the big show on a cash basis at the start.

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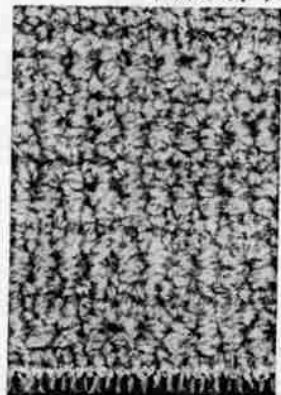
