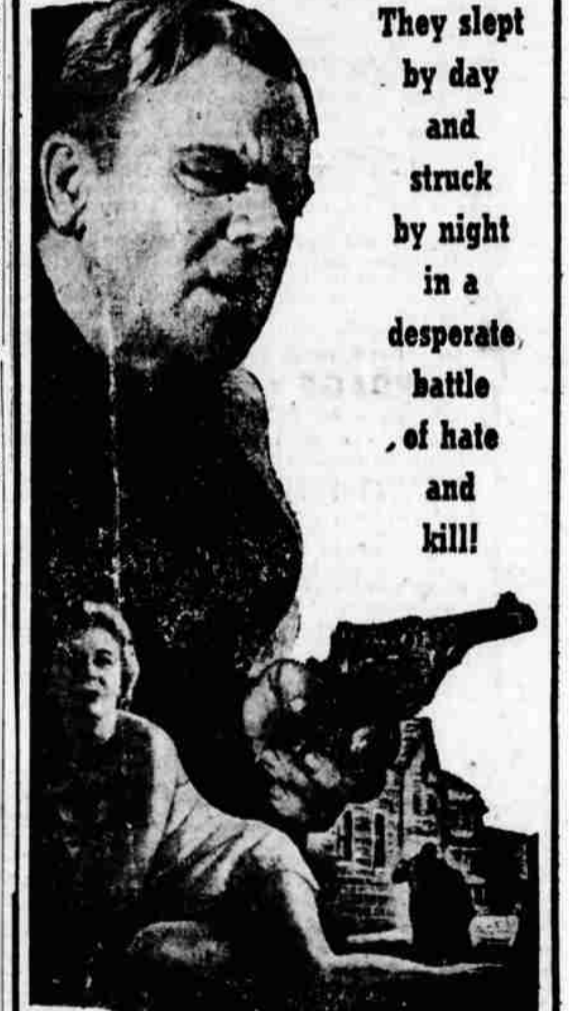

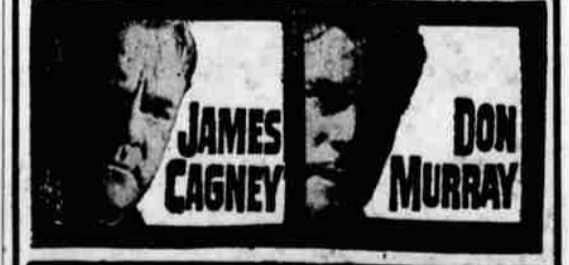
Brookins came to OTI from the State Department of Education in Salem, where he was assistant state supervisor of trade and industrial education.

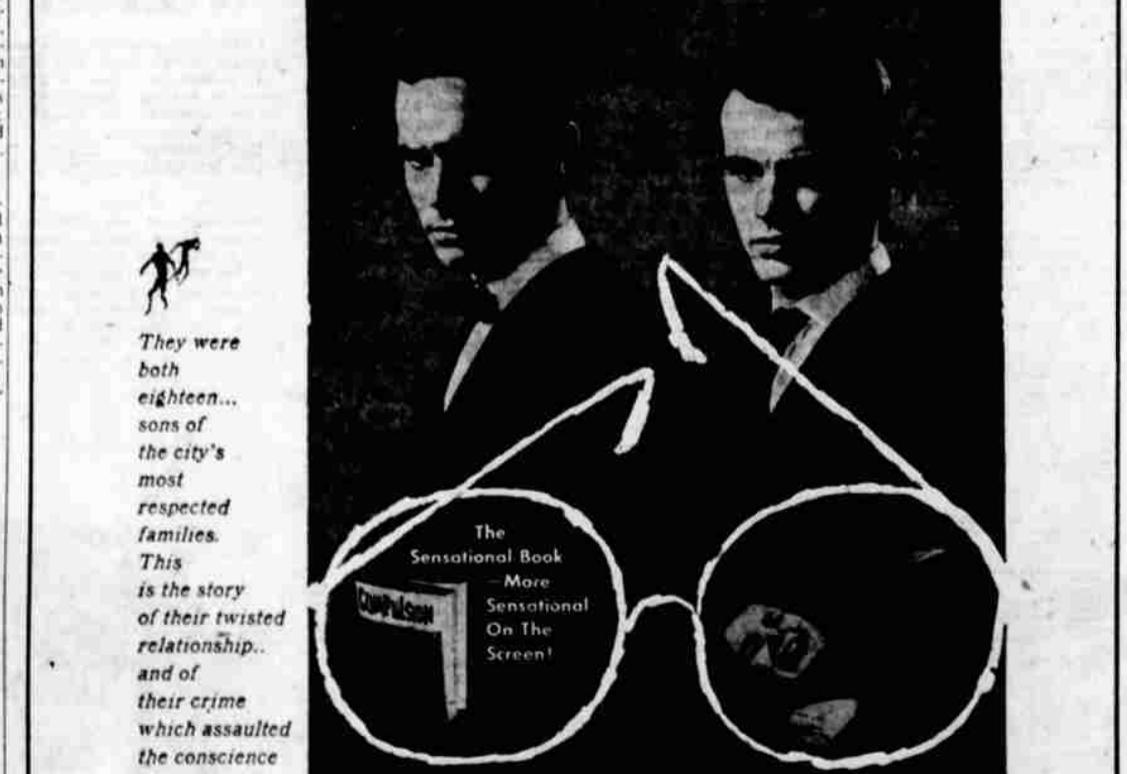
