

Women Speak But Not Vote, Church Says

SAN FRANCISCO (AP) — It's all right for the women among the 2 1/2 million Lutherans in the Missouri Synod to speak their mind on church business. But when it gets down to voting decisions, a doctrinal committee told the synod's 44th convention Saturday, the Scriptures say—let the men do it.

"Let your women keep silence in the churches; for it is not permitted unto them to speak; but they are commanded to be under obedience."—1 Corinthians 14:34. A few churches in the synod have let the women vote. At the last convention three years ago in St. Paul, Minn., a committee was assigned to look into this matter of women's suffrage in the church.

The committee, headed by the Rev. Walter W. Stuenkel of Milwaukee, has placed before the current convention views favoring a change. The committee report conceded it wasn't completely clear just how the early church handled the problem. But it quoted Corinthians and Timothy in support of its contention: "Women must not engage in preaching or in publicly teaching men in the church; whatever participation of women in congregational affairs is granted, the principal must be upheld that women do not usurp authority over men."

The committee urged that "All congregations who administer their affairs through the male voters' meeting are urged to continue this policy." As for churches which have granted such suffrage, the committee urged them to get back in line "in the light of scripture and the glorious position of woman in marriage and in the home."

"And if they will learn anything, let them ask their husbands at home; for it is a shame for women to speak in the church."—1 Corinthians 14:35. The committee's findings are endorsed in a resolution being brought before the current convention by the Intersynodical and Doctrinal Committee of Dr. R. P. Wiederanders of Corpus Christi, Tex. Its adoption is a foregone conclusion. The more than 600 voting delegates are all men. The women will be watching from the balconies.

Ex-Stage Coach Driver Recalls Days Of Youth

Jones Studies Boys, Girls Here, There

BERLIN (AP)—Novelist James Jones, after a 10-month look at Europe, says: "I don't think there's as much sexual frustration in Europe as there is in America. An oversimplified example are the young lovers walking along the quays of Paris and kissing. The French don't pay any attention to them, or at the most they give them a smile. "In America, those couples would be kicked off the street. "Also, I don't think European women are taught quite as much that they are sacred vessels. In Europe, women are something more than pedestal sitters. When they have a relationship with a man, it's a man-and-woman relationship, not a man-and-pedestal relationship." Jones took a puff on his pipe and explained what he thinks Europeans could learn from Americans: "All Europeans could stand a little more of the intrinsic human kindness which the Americans have. "Of course, the Americans haven't had enemies around them all the time like the people in Europe. That may have some influence." The author of "From Here to Eternity" and "Some Came Running" is working on a book about combat in the Pacific during World War II — "It is supposed to be a comic war novel." He is also gathering material for a novel that will have a Parisian setting and the late French jazz guitarist Django Reinhardt is a model for its central figure.

Amphitheater Found In Rome

ROME (UPI)—Ruins of a huge amphitheater, second in size only to the Colosseum, have been discovered in Rome. Art Superintendent Giulio Jacopi said Friday the site of the discovery is near the basilica of Santa Croce (Holy Cross), an ancient Roman structure where it is said Helene, the mother of Emperor Constantine, gathered relics of the passion of Christ. The digging thus far indicates that the amphitheater is about 500 yards long and 120 yards wide. The Colosseum in downtown Rome is 300 yards across at its widest part.
