SAN FRANCISCO (UPI)—Swashbuckling seamen and grizzled miners from San Francisco's early days would have a hard time recognizing the city's notorious Barbary Coast today. What once were several blocks of glittering gambling saloons, dingy basement dives and bawdy houses has been transformed into a center of the interior decorating industry.

There was a time, between 1862 and 1915, when the Coast showed Paris and New York what wickedness really meant. But a reform wave in 1915 closed it down and Prohibition was the final

blow. Repeal brought back the Coast under a new name—the "International Settlement," a string of tawdry night clubs.

Now private enterprise has carried out a redevelopment job that has obliterated all trace of the original Barbary Coast and ultra-fashionable showrooms display fine fabrics and modern furniture where once sin was king.
