WAIT! YOU STARTED THIS, ROMEO! IT WAS YOU WHO AST TO JOIN ME WADIN' IN TH' CREEK!

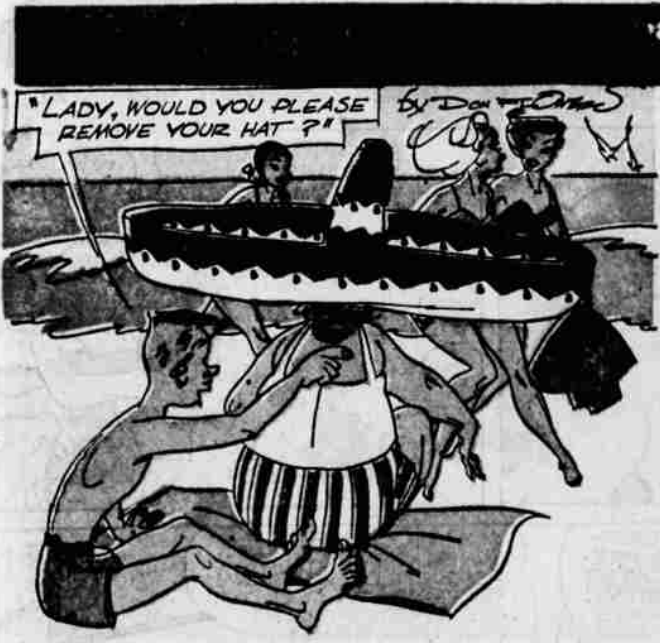
I MUST'VE BEEN OUT OF MY MIND! I DON'T LIKE TO GET MY FEET WET, EITHER!
