PIES

Vacation Tips

Headed for the beach? Stock up on two or three cans of hair spray to keep your curls under control and your hair from looking like a mess of wet seaweed, advises the Hollywood beauty expert. Having a glamorous hank of hair to pin on over hair that loses its coilure in the surf or pool—a cluster of curls, a chignon or a pair of bouffant wings—can be a god-send, Factor says, when you're vacationing miles from the nearest beauty shop.

If you're going to the mountains, carry as rich a cream as you use during the winter for combating skin dryness, induced even in the good old summer by a high altitude. As important to carry as your tooth brush, Factor reminds, is a water-softener to help your soap and shampoo lotion work up a lather in a bathroom basin.

If you're not sure of hot water, wherever you go, carry enough cleansing cream for make-up removal. And don't forget to include mascara-remover pads.

A refill for your cream-compact in a darker skin shade to use when your tan develops, makes an easy switch in your make-up box, and demands practically no extra space in your cosmetic bag also, interchangeable refills for your oval-mirror lipstick case in the new pale iridescent colors, plus one which is a golden frost, will sparkle your new vacation suntan into a new look.

CARAMELIZED SUGAR

If you are making caramel syrup for custard or some other use, add boiling rather than cold water to the melted sugar to have as little spattering as possible.

beautifully. Do not freeze custard or cream pies since they separate on defrosting. Rhubarb, cherry, blueberry, raspberry are easiest to freeze, since they retain their color. Apple and peach fillings must have color preservative added (ascorbic acid, sold under trade names at freezer supply counters). Use according to package directions.

Use oven glass, aluminum or foil pie plates. Freeze pies firm before wrapping. Remove from freezer, cover top with paper or foil pie plate for protection. Wrap in heavy duty foil and mark contents and date before which they must be used. Frozen pies keep 6 months, but you're sure to use them before.

All pies except chiffon are best frozen before baking. Prepare as usual but do not cut vents in top of two crust pies. Pour cooled cooked filling in baked shell of

chiffon pies. To serve frozen pies, remove wrapping from unbaked pies, cut vents in top crust and bake as usual, allowing 15 minutes additional time. If fruit pies bubble over, place a sheet of heavy duty foil a little larger than the pie and with edges turned up, on the shelf under the one on which the pie is baking.

Defrost chiffon pies to serving temperature without unwrapping and hold in the refrigerator until

the moment they go to table. **ICE CREAM PUFFS** These are easy and wonderful. Prepare them from cream puff mix or standard recipe. Bake in small sizes and large. Cool. Have ready squares of cardboard, foil covered, the right size to hold puffs for one meal. Slit the puffs, fill quickly with ice cream of any flavor and place on holders. Freeze until firm, then overwrap, mark and return to freezer. To serve Ice Cream Puffs, take

from freezer and serve frozen with a hot fruit, chocolate or butterscotch sauce. **FROZEN CREAM ROLL** This is another delightful dessert for the freezer. Prepare sponge cake or angel food mix. Bake in a foil lined jelly roll pan or 10 x 16 inch pan formed by turning up edges of 12 inch sheet of heavy duty foil 1 inch all around. Remove from pan as soon as taken from the oven and cut off crisp edges, if any. Roll up while hot and let

cool. Prepare whipped cream and flavor with instant coffee, instant cocoa or crushed berries, sweetened to taste. Unroll cake and spread with cream filling. Reroll, wrap in foil and freeze. Serve frozen. **COOKIES** Always useful cookies take wonderfully to the freezer. Cookies to be sliced, dropped, or rolled and cut, may be frozen unbaked in roll form, packed into milk containers or juice cans . . . or just

the dough may be frozen in small, easily defrosted amounts. All will keep for a year, well overwrapped in heavy duty foil. To bake frozen rolls or shaped dough, slice while frozen and bake on foil covered cookie sheets. Frozen dough may be used as soon as it can be handled. Bar type cookies such as brownies, and date nut bars can be frozen baked or unbaked in foil pans overwrapped in foil. Bake as usual, for defrost before serving.



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
