

Beach Barrel May Be Empty

PORT ORFORD, Ore. (AP)—A barrel marked "Danger—Radioactive Waste, AEC," which washed up on the beach here Saturday may be an empty container which was accidentally dropped into the ocean.

That theory was advanced by Rear Adm. Frank T. Watkins, commander of the 13th Naval District in Seattle.

The sealed metal drum at first was believed to have contained nuclear radiation.

But later, the Navy said that the clicking of the Geiger counter was caused by the reflection of the sun's rays on the sand—a normal reaction, which usually fools amateurs.

The Atomic Energy Commission in Washington, D.C., said that several firms are licensed to dispose of low-level radioactive wastes by dumping them into the sea. Usually, however, the barrels are weighted down with cement and thrown in where the ocean is very deep.

Admiral Watkins said the Navy has notified AEC officials about the barrel.

"Evidently," he said, "it's an empty container which dropped overboard someplace. As far as we can find there's nothing in it."
