

Housing Bill Strategy Rapped By Illinois Demo

WASHINGTON (AP)—Sen. Paul H. Douglas (D-Ill.) said today President Eisenhower's veto of the housing bill showed that Democrats had adopted the wrong strategy in cutting the measure down.

"It was supposed to be veto-proof when we sent it to him, but the veto didn't work very well," Douglas told a reporter. "We would have done better to send him a stronger bill, to make the issue clear."

The \$1,375,000,000 bill Eisenhower rejected Tuesday was cut down from a larger program passed separately by the House and Senate. But most of the cut-

was accomplished by limiting it to two years, leaving the annual spending rate much higher than Eisenhower asked.

Douglas and Sen. Joseph S. Clark (D-Pa.), both advocates of broad housing legislation, said they hoped the Senate leadership would call for a vote on overriding the veto even if the effort falls short of the necessary two-thirds.

"We ought to make the try," said Clark. "It will be a big help to use in states where this is an important issue."

Sen. Thomas H. Kurchel (R-Calif.), the Republican whip, said in a separate interview he did not think there would be such a test.

"I'm sure they don't have the votes to override," he said. "All they could do would be to put some Republicans from certain states on the spot and to try to win a political advantage."

In the House, Chairman Albert Rains (D-Ala.) of the Housing subcommittee said he would attempt to have the veto overridden. But most House leaders were waiting to see what action the Senate might take.

Senate Democratic leader Lyndon B. Johnson (D-Tex.), although vigorously assailing the veto, hasn't indicated what course he favors. Neither the Senate nor the

House originally passed the bill by the two-thirds margin that would be required to upset a veto.

The Senate must act first on overriding because the bill originated there. The vote could come any time in this Congress.

As a practical matter, though, the issue probably will be decided soon. If the bill cannot be revived, Democrats made it clear they would get to work and draft some alternative housing legislation.

Sen. John Sparkman (D-Ala.), the party's Senate housing expert, emphasized they would not be in any hurry to do so, and that further hearings would be likely.

There was some talk among Democrats of sending a new measure to the White House just before final adjournment this year on a take-it-or-leave-it basis.

Eisenhower called the \$1,375,000,000 bill extravagant and inflationary. But he also urged Congress to enact a six-point housing bill before quitting.

The President centered heavy criticism on what he called excessive provisions for urban renewal or slum clearance and on the inclusion of new low-rent public housing authorizations. He had proposed no new public housing units.

Douglas and Clark said these were the key sections of the bill from the standpoint of the cities.

They insisted that advocacy of strong programs in the two fields was a prime issue for Democrats from industrial states.

Johnson accused the President of an "all or nothing" attitude.
