Three American Air Units To Be Moved From France

PARIS (AP) — Three fighter-bomber wings of the U.S. Air Force will soon be moved from French bases to fields in Britain and West Germany, the United States announced today.

U.S. Ambassador to NATO W. Randolph Burgess made the decision known at a meeting of the North Atlantic Council.

The move had been generally expected because President

Charles de Gaulle will not agree to storing U.S. atomic arms on French soil.

The transfer will involve 200 jet fighter-bombers which have been assigned atomic missions in case of war. The move is to be started immediately and will be completed before the end of the summer.

The jets are based along the French-German frontier.

In the American view the French refusal to allow atomic stockpiles had made it impossible for the planes to fulfill their mission from French bases.

The shift to bases where atomic stockpiles would be close at hand was therefore the only logical military procedure, officials said.

The French have refused to commit their air force to an integrated NATO air defense in Europe, except for planes it assigned to tactical NATO support in Germany.

The decision was the first con-

crete American reaction to De Gaulle's increasingly independent attitude toward NATO.

Rail Tragedy Probe Starts

SAVANNAH, Ga. (AP) — With the death toll now at 23, the Interstate Commerce Commission prepared today to hear testimony on what might have caused the rail disaster June 28 at Meldrim.

The hearing seeks an explanation of what caused the derailment of 17 Seaboard Air Line freight cars on a trestle over the Ogeechee River near a crowded recreation area.

Included in the crackup were two tank cars loaded with butane. Seventeen persons died on the spot

when the gas exploded. Six others died later.

The 23rd victim, Phillip D. Carpenter, 31, of Pooler, died Wednesday. His son, Charles, 14, died of burns the day after the disaster.

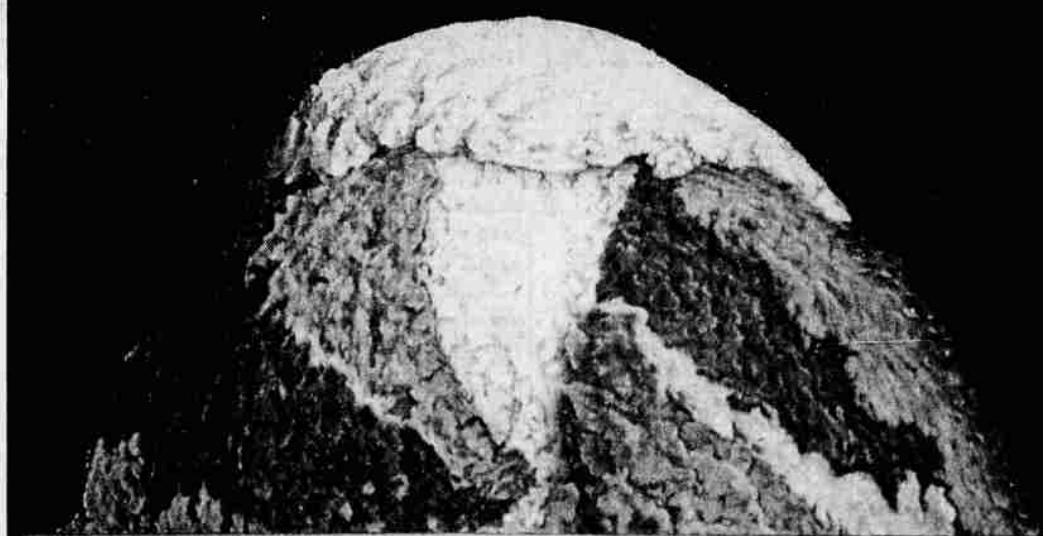
Sprinkle was in the truck when the duplicate key arrived.

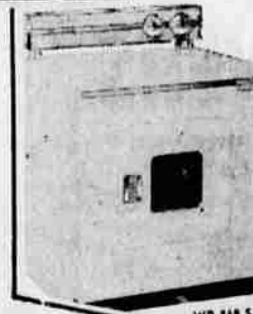
