

Phone Firm Garage Set

LAKEVIEW—Beaver State Telephone Company will build a \$20,000 garage and warehouse back of its central business offices at 410 North First Street, the company's division manager, William Castle, reported recently.

Castle said that the proposed structure — long needed by the company for storing vehicles and equipment—was one of several projects provided in Beaver State's \$118,000 construction budget for this year.

Another job called for in the 1959 budget will result in general cable relief throughout the city of Lakeview, according to Castle. This undertaking, started about 10 days ago, will require an expenditure of \$16,250 and 1,110 man-hours. The new facilities will enable Beaver State to fill orders for new and regraded service in the city.

Castle announced the completion of still another project in the 1959 construction package—installation of circuits to the Federal Aeronautics Administration's omnirange station on Round Mountain about 40 miles northwest of Lakeview. This was a joint undertaking of Beaver State and Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, and the new additions are primarily in the nature of control circuits whose purpose is to facilitate the station's role as a navigational aid to aircraft.

West Coast's expenditures on the project amounted to \$18,379 and 1,080 man-hours, Castle said the circuits from Round Mountain through to the new FAA network junction at Klamath Falls recently had been tested successfully.

Longtime Klamath Resident Takes Position In Phoenix

A resident of Klamath Falls for the last 28 years, Victor I. (Vic) Douglas, has announced he has taken a new position in Phoenix, Arizona, and he and Mrs. Douglas will leave here on July 28.

Douglas was born in Colorado

and came to the Klamath Basin in 1931. He and Floyd A. Boyd worked together in starting the International Harvester outlet at Tulelake in 1933.

From there, with a little time out to work in potatoes, Douglas went to J. W. Kerns Oreg. Ltd. in 1936 as a farm machinery salesman. His service with that company lasted for 18 years, except for one three-year period when he operated his own ranch and ran cattle in the Chiloquin area.

Upon leaving the Kerns organization he joined Fred Barnett Com-

pany, selling farm machinery, from which post he is resigning now.

Douglas has called square dances all over the Klamath Basin and their three children claim they have been going to square dances since before they could walk. He has also been prominent in rodeo activities in the Basin.

He is a charter member of Klamath Air Search and Rescue Unit and served as president for two years. He organized and is the leader of the Klamath County Mobilized Disaster Unit. In addition, he is a past governor of Moose Lodge here and a member of the Suburban Fire Department.

He started as a special Klamath County deputy sheriff under Sheriff Lloyd Low and has carried a badge for more than 20 years.

He played first baseman while Otto Ellis, Herald and News photographer, was second baseman on the Merrill baseball team in the early 1930s.

In Phoenix he will be superintendent for Water Engineering Company which covers Arizona, New Mexico, Texas and Nevada. The company's sprinkling systems are used in heavy construction work and road building.
