Home runs spelled the difference in Monday night's three Pacific Coast League games, as Vancouver pulled into the slimmest of league leads and Seattle stretched its winning string to four games.

Vancouver catcher Don Bishop, marking up his first PCL hit, belted out a homer in the eighth inning of a game at Spokane to give the Mounties a 6-4 victory. Rudy Regalado's leadoff home run in the second inning gave Seattle a 1-0 victory over Portland. The Rainiers' Bob Mabe held the Beavers to two hits.

In Salt Lake City, Hal Pritchard's tie-breaking homer in the eighth gave the Bees a 3-2 triumph over Phoenix. Dick Hall of the Bees posted his 11th mound win against a 3 losses in the series opener.

Vancouver's victory gave the Mounties a margin of one percentage point over Sacramento—.339 to .338. The Solons were idle, but will open a series in San Diego Tuesday night. The 19-year-old Bishop was playing his first game for Vancouver after coming to them from Aberdeen, S. D., of the Class C Northern League.

Seattle's Rainiers stretched out their longest victory string of the season behind the two-hit pitching of Bob Mabe. Mabe allowed one hit and struck out nine Portland batters. The Beavers' hits were singles by Clarence Moore and George Freese.

Salt Lake's Hall gave up five hits and struck out five. Pritchard was the Bees' big man at bat. He doubled in the sixth to score Hall, then scampered home on a single by Chuck Harmon.
