

Balsiger BR Team Upsets East Side

The Balsiger Babe Ruth League baseball team slipped into the No. 1 spot in the standings and is eyeing a very possible 1959 league championship off their upset victory over the powerful East Side Electric nine in Gem Stadium Wednesday night.

The game, the second half of twinbill, followed Merrill's 17-10 defeat over the winless Moyina Heights Cinderellas. Both games were shifted from their original playing site at Conger Field to the stadium in order to accommodate the big crowd that gathered to watch the virtual championship match between the East Siders and the Fordmen.

The Ford squad made the best use of four hits, 11 walks off losing ES hurler Kent Hunsaker, and seven East Side fielding mistakes in grabbing off their popular victory. The win was credited to Balsiger reliever, lefty Marvin Davis, who entered the game in the third inning as the replacement for little Larry Binney. Davis, in the remaining four frames allowed only one Electric tally off two hits. He walked three and struck out three.

Binney was reached for four hits, a double by Hunsaker in the first, singles by John Robinson and Ted Crutchfield followed by a resounding two-baser by Dave Stippich in the second. The East Siders collected a total of six hits but the seven errors, the free passes, a pair of wild pitches and a passed ball proved their undoing.

A spectacular catch by Balsiger leftfielder Dwight Schuh spoiled Bill Kennitzer's seemingly sure double with no out in the big ES third inning.

Another East Side score threat

was nipped in the sixth after the bases were loaded with no out. Leftfielder Grover Dahn walked, advanced on Larry Sanders' sharp single which was followed by a walk granted Mike Gallagher. An infield fly off the bat of Robinson resulted in a double play when shortstop Doug Floyd caught Dahn trying for home.

The Balsiger crew notched three in the third and four in the sixth to insure their win. The first three came off no hits, two errors, a wild pitch and four walks.

In the sixth, after two were out, John Lawson got on with an error. Floyd, Fred Guntan and Davis walked and they all cashed in when Stippich committed an infield miscue and an overthrow followed by a wild pitch off Hunsaker.

Dennis Coleman led the Fordmen with a single and double in five trips while Hunsaker and Stippich each collected doubles and Sanders added a pair of singles for the East Siders.

The Moyina Heights nine continued their losing ways although they out-hit the Merrill squad. An error, some timely stolen bases, a balk, and a triple by Merrill shortstop Larry Chance gave the county club all the runs they needed in the seventh. The loss was charged to Ron Head and the victory went to Sam Walker.

The Central Point nine will have Bill Anhorn, John Anhorn and Bob Samples ready for action on the mound.
