BUFFET SALAD

Summer luncheon specialties that offer time-saving features for hostesses are always welcome, especially when the specialty is ideally suited for buffet service, like this hearty salad. New Citrus Buffet Salad is such a dish; and, with its combination of many ingredients placed in rows atop a bed of greens, needs no more than appetizer, dessert and beverage to complete your menu.

Prepare Citrus Buffet Salad in advance and keep in the refrigerator. When guests arrive, serve Green Turtle Soup on the rocks as a starter. CITRUS BUFFET SALAD
1 package (9 ounces) quick-frozen artichoke hearts
1/2 head lettuce
1 small bunch chicory
1 head romaine
1 bunch water cress
Sections from 2 grapefruits
3 hard-cooked eggs
1/2 pound bacon, crisply fried
2 cups finely diced cooked chicken
1/2 cup crumbled bleu cheese

COCOA KRISPIE TREATS

Melt 1/4 cup butter or margarine in a 3-quart saucepan. Add 1/2 pound (about 32 regular size) marshmallows or three cups miniature marshmallows and cook over low heat, stirring constantly until marshmallows are melted and the mixture well-blended. Remove from heat and stir in five cups Kellogg's Cocoa Flavored Krispies. Stir until well-coated with the marshmallow mixture. Press warm mixture lightly into a buttered 13x9-inch pan. Cut into squares when cool. Yield: 24 two-inch squares.

Note: Two cups marshmallow creme may be substituted for the marshmallows. Cook with butter over low heat about five minutes, stirring constantly.

LUNCHEON SALAD

Quick but elegant luncheon salad for unexpected summer company: slice California mid-summer cantaloupes into halves or thirds, depending on size. Remove seeds. Place on individual salad plates and fill with fresh berries, sliced plums or peaches or any canned or fresh fruits on hand. Drizzle with a lemon and honey dressing. Cinnamon toast fingers. Tiny hot biscuits or slices of canned date bread are good accompaniments.

GO-TOGETHERS

Fresh dates stuffed with a sharp cheddar or a milk jack cheese go well with sandwiches or a cold meat platter. The sweet, chewy dates added to cottage cheese along with some grated orange or lemon rind and a little seasoned salt makes a good summer salad combination.

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EAT 'EM like peanuts — Kellogg's new Cocoa flavored Krispies almost look like nuts and make a wonderful nibbling snack as well as an unusual treat as a breakfast cereal. Serve them as topping on ice cream or for candy making, as well.

Market Baskets Expanding No. 1 Store

The convenience and comfort of the customer was taken fully into consideration by Norman Duffy and Dick Hicks when they laid out plans for remodeling of Market Basket No. 1 at 122 North Ninth Street.

Wider aisles, free-flowing traffic and greater ease in getting from one department to another are all being achieved in the current expansion program going on at the store.

The construction work is being done by Warren H. Parr, general contractor, and involves moving the store offices, changing partitions at the rear of the store and redecorating.

Greater grocery display area is being provided. All of the 18-foot gondolas are being replaced by 24-foot gondolas which will permit more attractive displays, Duffy said.

The enlarged produce department is being dressed up through the use of "champagne board" hardboard in misty walnut with a wood grain design. The frozen

food department is being allotted increased space, too, and—in all—a total of 1,000 square feet of shopping area is being added.

Prompter service is going to be made possible through the installation of a fifth check out station.

No store policies are being changed and the Market Basket will continue to feature service meats.

Duffy indicated that "it would be nice if we had some way to expand our customer parking area" at this time.

"We certainly appreciate our customers' thoughtfulness in not overparking, however," he added. There is no interruption of business during the remodeling.
