CONSCIENCE BOTHERS MAN
OAKLAND, Calif. (AP)—Lewis E. Clayburg, 72, has gone without Social Security payments for seven years, he told the FBI Thursday, because he deserted the Navy in World War I and was afraid to collect payments under a false name.
Clayburg walked into the Navy recruiting station Wednesday, the FBI said, and surrendered as a deserter because "I want to get it off my chest."
Once a ship's carpenter and now a farm and odd job worker, Clayburg said he went on a drinking spree Aug. 7, 1917, from his post at Bremerton, Wash. Navy base, "woke up in Oregon" and decided not to go back.
The FBI said a check with Washington, D.C., failed to turn up any "wanted" status for Clayburg.

'Old Warrior' To Be Scrapped
OAKLAND, Calif. (AP)—The scrapper's torch is going to deal the "Fighting Mary" the death blow the Japanese never could. In two or three weeks, five tugs will tow the 31,500-ton battleship Maryland from Bremerton, Wash., to Oakland to be reduced to scrap by the Learner Co.
Eight months will be required to cut up the old warrior that survived attack at Pearl Harbor and carried the war to the shores of Okinawa.
The Maryland was taken out of service in April 1947.
