### Cook School Set Tuesday

A free beef barbecue cooking school will be held at Klamath County Fairgrounds from 1:30 to 3 p.m. next Tuesday.

Klamath County Cow Belles are sponsors of the event which will be presented by Bev Lyons, home demonstrator for California Oregon Power Company, Medford, and Barney Duin, Safeway Stores, Inc., Portland.

Montgomery Ward & Company is providing the barbecue grill for cooking and lawn furniture to dress up the big exhibit room at the fairgrounds, according to Mrs. Homer DeLamater, Cow Belle president.

Patio accessories are also expected to be loaned for the occasion by Lucas Furniture and Adair's Furniture stores.

Kirkpatrick's East Side Appliances has agreed to donate the use of Westinghouse range and refrigerator as they did for the last Cow Belle beef cooking school, Mrs. DeLamater said.

The Cow Belles will bring homemade cookies to serve with iced tea to the guests. Mrs. Lyons always invites the guests to sample the dishes they have watched being prepared and Duin says he expects a big turnout of men.

### Red Prisoner Lives On Hope

HONG KONG (AP)—John Downey of New Britain, Conn., serving a life sentence in a Red China prison, is living on hope, his brother William said today on arrival from Peiping.

But the Chinese he talked to during the week he spent in the Red capital gave him no indication that John will be released, William told reporters.

He said that despite requests through the Chinese Red Cross, no Chinese government official would receive him or listen to his appeal. The Communists jailed John Downey in 1952 on espionage charges.

"But my brother shows no sign of despair," William said. "He is quite cheerful, was very happy to see me and appears to be in very good health. He is living in hopes that he will be released."

William said he was not allowed to visit Richard G. Fecreau of Boston, Mass., who was sentenced to 20 years at the same time as John.

Fecreau and Downey, civilians, were captured when a U.S. Air Force plane in which they were traveling crashed on a flight from Japan to Korea.

William saw John three times for two hours each during the week he was in Peiping.

### Reds Speed Up U.S. Action, Says Pennsylvania Solon

WASHINGTON (AP)—Rep. Francis E. Walter (D-Pa.) said today the Kremlin has sent orders to U.S. Communists to intensify training of key revolutionaries in sabotage, subversion and penetration.

Walter, chairman of the House Committee on Un-American Activities, made the statement in opening committee hearings on Communist training operations.

Walter said that in May of this year James E. Jackson Jr., whom he described as "one of the top Communist conspirators operating in the United States," returned here from Moscow.

"Jackson's orders from the Kremlin, which have now been transmitted to the comrades in the United States, are to intensify the training of key revolutionaries in sabotage, subversion and penetration," Walter said.

The committee chairman also said the committee has under subpoena "the educational director of the Communist party, Hyman Lumer who, we have learned from our field investigators, is now supervising the secret training programs in key centers of the nation in which select comrades are given specialized training in conspiratorial strategies and tactics."

In its hearings Walter said the committee expects to explore a new school known as the Faculty of Social Science to see if for all intents and purposes it is "merely a successor" to the Jefferson School of Social Science.

Walter did not identify the new school further. The Jefferson School of Social Science in New

York was found to be a Communist front organization by the Subversive Activities Control Board on June 30, 1955.

Walter said that shortly thereafter the school was dissolved but "it was not long before there was created with substantially the same faculty and courses, a new school known as the Faculty of Social Science."

The chairman said trained, disciplined Communist agents now number "a worldwide fifth column of some 33 million."

### Teachers' Pay Said Very Low

CHICAGO (AP)—A survey of Chicago Public Schools salaries shows the highest rated teachers earn less than some school maintenance men.

The school board said Tuesday a consulting survey firm found that 32 engineer-custodians, who are in "class five engineer-custodians," receive \$11,160 for a 12-month year.

The highest classified pay for teachers is the 10-month \$8,500 salary paid to teachers who hold doctorate degrees and have 31 years of service.

### BOMB EXPLOSION

GUATEMALA (AP)—Two bombs were exploded Tuesday night in front of the American Embassy and another against the palace of the Roman Catholic archbishop of Guatemala. The blasts damaged the buildings slightly, but no one was hurt.
